OCCUPATIONAL SPECIALIZATION INFORMATION (BS-AS)

ALL training must be approved by a designated University Committee to be included for Occupational Specialization credit.

TRAINING:

- may come from vocational/technical courses from a college or university, continuing education courses, employer sponsored seminars, military schools, etc.
- must be documented (transcripts, certificate of completion, employer training records, etc.)
- must equate to 12 to 36 semester hour equivalents (0 to 24 semester hours of approved electives may be added to the training hours to total 36 hours of occupational specialization)

Each prospective BA-AS student is evaluated individually to determine eligibility for the degree program. Various community college courses may be used as part of the Occupational Specialization.
