

PRESENTING THE DEMONSTRATION

1. Show and explain completely the procedure by going through the process step-by-step.
2. Perform the demonstration slowly enough so that students do not miss key points.
3. Be sure to explain new terms.
4. Emphasize safe practices as you proceed.
5. Show the best procedure to do the job.
6. Question your students as the demonstration proceeds.
7. Watch for non-verbal clues from students.
8. Set up standards of workmanship, by doing a good thorough job, that will challenge your students.
9. Encourage your students by showing ease of performing tasks.
10. Summarize the steps and key points.
11. Ask summarizing questions.
