



Student Teaching Integral Assignments

1. Lesson Plans: Choose and submit **one** lesson plan used in your assigned classes each week in the format required by AGSD 420. This lesson will be the one we use to evaluate your planning progress each week for the remainder of the semester. ***Your lesson plans will be submitted via email to Drs. McGregor, Tarpley and Graham each Friday of your student teaching experience by _____ pm.***
2. Student Teacher Profile:
 - a. Submit a copy of your Student Teacher Profile at each of the designated time intervals. You and your cooperating teacher must prepare this report.
 - i. Submit the profile at the student teaching seminar and at the end of the semester. This will be a progress report as well as your final report used by the department for evaluation and accreditation purposes.
3. Local News Release: Send a news release to your local newspaper concerning your presence as a student teacher at your student teaching center. You will need to provide a copy of the **printed** news release at one of the seminars.
4. Cooperating Teacher Weekly Reports: These are the web-based reports that your cooperating teacher is asked to submit weekly providing regular feedback to the teacher educators regarding your performance. It is your responsibility to remind your cooperating teacher that this form must be completed and submitted weekly.
5. Weekly Reports: Keeping records is an important component of being an educator. Also, the department has to meet certain requirements for your field experience, therefore, student teachers are asked to complete a weekly report and submit it via email. The form for the student teacher weekly report can be found online. Please send in weekly reports to Drs. McGregor, Tarpley and Graham.
6. School Legalities: Legal issues in public education will be a major component of your PPR test. Purchase and read the school legalities text.
7. Portfolio & Employment Information: The Department of Agricultural Services & Development will post a photo, personal statement and a link to your electronic portfolio on the departmental website in order to assist student teachers in gaining employment. Your portfolio and other employment information must be completed before the student teacher seminar.
8. FFA Assignment: Dr. Tarpley will have an FFA assignment to be completed during your field experience.
9. Teaching Methods Assignment: Too often teachers find one or two teaching methods that work well and then settle down and use only these methods. This assignment encourages you, with your cooperating teacher's help, to try different procedures and techniques and to evaluate your results. From the lists of different methods provided in ASD 410 & 420 (and any others you can find), working with your cooperating teacher, plan and use a **minimum** of 10 different methods. Evaluate, and **have your cooperating teacher(s) evaluate** your results and note any modifications you will make next time you use each method. The form for this assignment is provided online.
