- Civic/Community Activities – This could include involvement in community groups, such as Lions Club, chamber of commerce, etc. – This should be in a bulleted format.
- Two JPEG Pictures – One picture should be of you interacting with students. The other picture should be a head and shoulders professional photo of you.

How and when should you submit your bio?

- Please send this via an e-mail attachment. One word document should include your philosophy on teaching leadership, your career highlights, and your civic/community activities. You can simply attach the two JPEG photos.
