- I. Catalog Description: Designed to expand upon the Federal Aviation Regulations relating to various specialized facets of the aviation industry, including airline operations, aircraft certification, air-worthiness standards and airport operations

- III. Expanded Course Description: Air Carrier Operations prepares the student with the background information necessary to pass the Airline Transport Pilot Test. In addition, this course is designed to expand upon the Federal Aviation Regulations relating to various facets of the aviation industry, including airline operations, aircraft certification, air-worthiness standards and airport operations
- IV. Intended Student Learning Outcomes: Upon completion of this course, the student will be able to:
  - A. Apply a higher level of understanding to air carrier operations.
  - B. Be familiar with the content of the ATP written test
