## **Master Course Syllabus Outline**

**Department:** Engineering and Physics

**Course Prefix/Number:** HYDR 440-1

**Official Course Title:** Internship

**I. Catalog Description:** Work experience with consulting firms, government agencies, and other practitioners. This course emphasizes student's practical experiences. Cannot be taken more than once for credit.

**II. Prerequisite:** GEOL 105, HYDR 110

**III. Expanded Course Description:** The course provides student the opportunity to get the first knowledge of hydrologic practices and typical careers. The student is required to work with consulting firms, government agencies, and other practitioners. Upon the completion, the student is required to write and submit a report.

**IV. Intended Student Outcomes:**

- Gain a visual understanding of hydrologic practices and careers
- Gain a preliminary understanding of the education and training requirements to be a hydrologic professional
- Gain somewhat hands-on experiences on hydrologic practices
- Study technical communication skills
