POST-BACCALAUREATE ADMISSIONS

A student who has a bachelor's degree from an accredited U.S. institution and who is in good standing at all schools previously attended but who is not seeking a master's degree or professional certification may apply as a post-baccalaureate student. A post-baccalaureate student may work on a second bachelor's degree or teaching certification or take courses of interest. To be admitted to post-baccalaureate status, an applicant must submit official transcript(s) from all schools attended, a signed application form or completed electronic application, a \$30 application fee, a tuition residency form and a Post-Baccalaureate form.
