585-v Graduate Seminar for Agriculture and Environmental Science. (1-0) A graduate seminar with content varying according to the needs and experiences of students and the instructor of record. May be repeated for up to three hours credit as content varies. Credit for more than a combined total of 3 hours of AGRI 585, ANSC 585 or ENVS 585 will not be granted. Cross-listed with ENVS 585 and ANSC 585. Prerequisite Course(s): Open to all students with graduate classification majoring in agriculture.

In course descriptions, the digit following the course number is the number of semester credit hours. For example, ENGL 111-3 is a freshman level course worth 3 semester hours of credit. The numbers in parentheses following the course number (for example, 3-2) indicate the number of clock hours per week devoted to theory and practice, respectively. (WI) indicates that sections of this course will be offered as writing intensive.
