**107-3 General Animal Science. (2-2)** (TCCNS = AGRI 1319) The scientific study of animal agriculture involving beef cattle, swine, sheep, goats, and horses. Subjects covered will include management practices involving reproduction, nutrition, health, handling, genetic selection, and shelter. Marketing strategies and procedures. Lab fee \$13. Course fee \$10.

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In course descriptions, the digit following the course number is the number of semester credit hours.
