210-3 Introduction of Veterinary Science. (3-0) An introduction to veterinary science including structure and function of major body systems, nutrition, diseases, and surgical principles. Both farm animals and companion animals will be discussed. Course fee \$10.
Prerequisite Course(s): ANSC 107: General Animal Science
