310-4 Principles of Equine Reproduction. (3-2) Application of fundamental concepts and principles of equine genetics, breeding and reproduction. Lab fee \$15. Prerequisite Course(s): ANSC 308: Physiology of Reproduction Co-Requisite Course(s): ANSC 213: Horse Psychology and Training or permission of instructor based on documentation of prior experience with stallions.
