520-3 Beef Cattle Feedlot Management. (3-0) A study of the operation of industrial feedlots. Design of feedlots, economics, technical nutrition, cattle management, marketing, and consumer relations. Prerequisite Course(s): ANSC 309: Feeds and Feeding and graduate classification.
