219-4 Human Anatomy and Physiology. (3-2) (TCCNS = BIOL 2401) Basic physiological principles and their applications in the study of the skeletal, muscular, and nervous systems are emphasized. Substantial microscopic observation required. Course fee \$40. Lab fee \$10.
