442-3 Marine Ecology. (3-0) Study of marine ecosystems including physical, chemical, and biological factors which influence the distribution of marine organisms. Prerequisite Course(s): BIOL 120: General Biology and BIOL 121: General Biology and BIOL 401: Ecology or approval by the department head.
