461-4 Animal Physiology. (3-3) Basic principles of life processes and how they apply to the integrated functions of organ systems. Functions of the various organ systems of animals are studied. Lab fee \$10. Prerequisite Course(s): 12 hours of BIOL and one semester of organic chemistry with laboratory.

In course descriptions, the digit following the course number is the number of semester credit hours. For example, ENGL 111-3 is a freshman level course worth 3 semester hours of credit. The numbers in parentheses following the course number (for example, 3-2) indicate the number of clock hours per week devoted to theory and practice, respectively.
