478-3 Biochemistry Lab. (1-5) Principles and applications of basic methodology for the isolation, purification, characterization, and quantitative determination of biologically important compounds. Credit for both BIOL 478 and CHEM 478 will not be awarded. Lab fee \$15. Prerequisite Course(s): BIOL 474: Biochemistry I or CHEM 474: Biochemistry I or concurrent enrollment, or approval of department head.

In course descriptions, the digit following the course number is the number of semester credit hours. For example, ENGL 111-3 is a freshman level course worth 3 semester hours of credit. The numbers in parentheses following the course number (for example, 3-2) indicate the number of clock hours per week devoted to theory and practice, respectively.
