509-3 Cellular Biology. (3-0) A study of cellular morphology and function at the ultrastructural and molecular level. Prerequisite Course(s): Organic chemistry and 18 hours of BIOL or approval by the department head.

In course descriptions, the digit following the course number is the number of semester credit hours. For example, ENGL 111-3 is a freshman level course worth 3 semester hours of credit. The numbers in parentheses following the course number (for example, 3-2) indicate the number of clock hours per week devoted to theory and practice, respectively.
