420-3 Writing for Electronic Mediums. (3-0) Advanced study of and practice in writing for electronic mediums with a primary focus on planning, designing, and composing professional pages for the world wide web. Course fee \$10. Prerequisite Course(s): ENGL 111: Introduction to College Composition and ENGL 112: College Composition and Research 3 hours sophomore ENGL and ENGL 309: Technical Writing & Document Design and ENGL 312: Graphics and Technical Writing

In course descriptions, the digit following the course number is the number of semester credit hours. For example, ENGL 111-3 is a freshman level course worth 3 semester hours of credit. The numbers in parentheses following the course number (for example, 3-2) indicate the number of clock hours per week devoted to theory and practice, respectively.
