550-3 Studies in Literature Before 1500. (3-0) A study of representative types of pre-1500 literature in English. Topics may vary. May be repeated for credit when topics vary.

In course descriptions, the digit following the course number is the number of semester credit hours. For example, ENGL 111-3 is a freshman level course worth 3 semester hours of credit. The numbers in parentheses following the course number (for example, 3-2) indicate the number of clock hours per week devoted to theory and practice, respectively.
