450-3 Retail Horticulture. (2-2) The establishment and management of a retail store with emphasis on plant display, care, and marketing in a retail environment, and on customer relations with respect to common home and landscape problems. Lab fee \$10. Prerequisite Course(s): Junior classification or approval of department head.
