147-4 Theory I: Basics of Music. (3-2) Introduction to music fundamentals, staff, clefs, key signatures, scales, time signatures and notation; meter and rhythm; chords; harmony; melodic organization and structure; use of Musical Instrument Digital Interface (MIDI); aural skills. Computer software used for some written and ear-training assignments. Course fee \$10. Lab fee \$5. Prerequisite Course(s): A passing grade on the placement examinations in theory and aural skills.

In course descriptions, the digit following the course number is the number of semester credit hours. For example, ENGL 111-3 is a freshman level course worth 3 semester hours of credit. The numbers in parentheses following the course number (for example, 3-2) indicate the number of clock hours per week devoted to theory and practice, respectively. (WI) indicates that sections of this course will be offered as writing intensive.
