205-4 Clinical Pharmacology and Pathophysiology. (3-3) Emphasizes concepts relevant to various adaptive and disease processes that alter human functioning. The effects of pharmacotherapeutic agents on these processes and the effect of these processes on medication metabolism are highlighted. Clinical experiences will include interpretation and integration of selected laboratory findings. Course fee \$20. Lab fee \$10. Prerequisite Course(s): Admission to the Nursing Program.

In course descriptions, the digit following the course number is the number of semester credit hours. For example, ENGL 111-3 is a freshman level course worth 3 semester hours of credit. The numbers in parentheses following the course number (for example, 3-2) indicate the number of clock hours per week devoted to theory and practice, respectively.
