**302-4 Maternal-Newborn Health Nursing. (2-6)** Focus is on culturally sensitive care for individuals within the context of family and community during the childbearing period including care of the neonate. Clinical experiences are provided in a variety of health care settings. Course fee \$20. Lab fee \$10. Prerequisite Course(s): NUR 322: Health Assessment and NUR 323: Nursing Care of Adults Co-Requisite Course(s): NUR 325: Scholarly Inquiry in Nursing
