(2-6) Emphasizes the use of the nursing process in caring for the young and middle-aged population with emphasis on critical thinking, therapeutic nursing intervention, and effective communication. Clinical practicum provides opportunities to examine the medical-surgical problems and developmental disorders among the young and middle-aged adult population. Course fee \$20. Lab fee \$10. Prerequisite Course(s): NUR 301: Family Health Nursing and NUR 308 and NUR 309: Nursing Care of Children and Adolescents
