409-5 Advanced Technology and Nursing. (3-6) Combines knowledge of biomedical and information technologies with developing awareness of our human capacity for caring. Clinical emphasis is on the safe and effective use of advanced technology in the delivery of nursing care to individuals who experience major and complex alterations in physiological, psychosocial, and spiritual health. Course fee \$20. Lab fee \$10. Prerequisite Course(s): NUR 302: Maternal-Newborn Health Nursing and NUR 310. and NUR 303: Behavioral Health Nursing and NUR 322: Health Assessment and NUR 411: Nursing Research or concurrent registration.
