411-2 Nursing Research. (2-0) Emphasis is on an applied understanding of evidence based practice as it relates to the science of nursing. Focuses on appraisal, critique and dissemination of nursing research. Pre-requisites: MATH 131 or 300, NUR 311. Course fee \$20. Prerequisite Course(s): MATH 300: Principles of Statistics and MATH 350: Principles of Bio-Statistics and NUR 325: Scholarly Inquiry in Nursing

In course descriptions, the digit following the course number is the number of semester credit hours. For example, ENGL 111-3 is a freshman level course worth 3 semester hours of credit. The numbers in parentheses following the course number (for example, 3-2) indicate the number of clock hours per week devoted to theory and practice, respectively.
