385-3 Fish and Wildlife Laws and Administration. (3-0) A review and analysis of state and federal laws and international treaties and conventions affecting fish and wildlife; their application and administration. The organizational structure of state, federal and international agencies; their objectives, policies and practices. Course fee \$5. Prerequisite Course(s): WLDM 221: Wildlife Conservation and Management and junior classification.
