

## Wildlife Management

**440-3 Wildlife Field Studies. (0-6)** A field course in which students capture, measure, and mark animals; collect descriptive measures of vegetation that characterize wildlife habitat; and record field observations using a journal. This course requires a one-week field trip at student's expense (in addition to field experience fee). Field experience fee \$75. Prerequisite Course(s): WLDM 221: Wildlife Conservation and Management and and WLDM 310: Wildlife Management Techniques
