

Wildlife Management

484-3 Internship. (0-6) Formally arranged and approved on-the-job training with a cooperating sponsor in government or private sector of the wildlife management or natural resources field. A minimum of 40 hours of training is required for each hour of academic credit. A maximum of six hours may be earned by internship completion. Oral and written reports of internship experience required. Field experience fee \$75. Prerequisite Course(s): Advanced standing and approval of department head.

In course descriptions, the digit following the course number is the number of semester credit hours. For example, ENGL 111-3 is a freshman level course worth 3 semester hours of credit. The numbers in parentheses following the course number (for example, 3-2) indicate the number of clock hours per week devoted to theory and practice, respectively. (WI) indicates that sections of this course will be offered as writing intensive.
