

Do I Qualify for \$1,000 Tuition Rebate?

STUDENTS MUST APPLY FOR THE TUITION REBATE PRIOR TO RECEIVING THEIR BACHELOR'S DEGREE

You may be eligible for \$1,000 upon graduation if you meet the following criteria:

You are a Texas resident.

You have been entitled to pay Texas resident tuition at **all** times while pursuing your degree.

This is your **first** baccalaureate degree.

You **enrolled** for the first time in an institution of higher education in the Fall 1997 semester or later (no college hours prior to Fall 1997).

- This **does not** include CLEP hours.
- This **does** include college hours taken during high school.

You have attempted no more than **3** hours in excess of the minimum number of semester credit hours required to complete your degree under the catalog under which you graduated.

- Attempted hours include:
 - Transfer credits
 - All credit earned by examination in excess of 9 hrs
 - Courses that are dropped
 - Optional internship and cooperative education courses
 - Developmental courses
 - Repeated courses

Beginning with students for the first time in fall 2005, a student must also graduate in a timely manner to earn the tuition rebate. Detailed information regarding this and other requirements to qualify for the rebate can be found at www.collegefortexans.com.
