**THE JOE W. AUTRY SCHOLARSHIP IN AGRICULTURE**

Dr. Autry was a teacher and Vice President Emeritus.

**DR. MARY ANN BLOCK FAMILY CONSUMER SCIENES EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP**

Dr. Block was a long time professor of Human Sciences at Tarleton, serving as Department Head at the time of her retirement.

**KACEE BRADLEY TOP HAND RODEO SCHOLARSHIP**

Brother in law of Tarleton's Mark Eakin. Kacee often volunteered to help with the Rodeo team.

**ARTHUR J. CARTER ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP**

Father of Tarleton's Cynthia Carter. This scholarship is awarded to students from Waco and McLennan County.

**BEATRICE ROBINSON CARTER NURSING ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP**

Established by Cynthia Carter in memory of her mother.

**THE CHILTON ENDOWMENT IN COMPUTER INFORMATION SYSTEMS**

Dr. Stuart Chilton served in many leadership roles while employed at Tarleton from 1954 to 1966 and Dr. Brad Chilton is currently the Vice President for Enrollment and Information Management at Tarleton.

**THE PAUL & OPAL CUNYUS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Mr. Cunyus was the associate dean and served in that capacity for 25 years.

**THE J. THOMAS DAVIS ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP**

Dean Davis served as the Dean of John Tarleton Agricultural College for many years.

**THE DAWSON-BLANCHARD INDUSTRIAL EDUCATION & TECHNOLOGY SCHOLARSHIP**

This scholarship was established in 1987 as a memorial to C.H. Dawson and E. A. "Doc" Blanchard who both served as faculty members.

**THE EVANS-HAWES SCHOLARSHIP**

Dr. Evans served as Department Head of Agronomy, Horticulture, and Agricultural Economics.

After serving in the armed forces for four years, he returned to Tarleton as a professor in the Mathematics Department and track coach. On August 25, 1977 Tarleton renamed the track at Memorial Stadium the "Oscar H. Frazier Memorial Track" in his honor.

**THE RICHARD C. SCHAFFER CLINICAL LAB SCIENCES SCHOLARSHIP**

Dr. Schaffer has been an important contributor and friend to Tarleton for many years.
