



It is the policy of Tarleton State University, in compliance with the Texas Legislative Bill 4189, that all first time students and new transfer students living on-campus show evidence of immunization against Bacterial Meningitis. This information shall be maintained in accordance with Family Education Rights and Privacy Act Regulations. In order to comply with House Bill 4189, signed into law by Governor Rick Perry, Residential Living & Learning requires documentation of your Meningitis vaccination.

All documentation must be submitted by January 1, 2010. Any student failing to provide documentation by January 1, 2010 will be unable to reside in a residential facility.

You must have documentation on file or you will be unable to occupy any space on campus, but will still be held to the University's on-campus residency policy. Note: By state law, documentation must be submitted 10 (ten) days prior to occupancy.

Any student lacking appropriate documentation will be required to secure off-campus accommodations at his or her own personal expense until *he or she is in compliance* with the state law.
