Step 1—Submit an Application

As part of this process you will submit a completed application to the Residential Living & Learning office (on the second floor of the Tarleton Center) by **Tuesday, November 3rd at 5:00 p.m.** When you submit your application, please make sure to sign up for a group process date and time. The four dates/times to choose from are noted below:

Thursday, November 12th from 4-6 pm, meet in Centennial Lobby

Thursday, November 12th from 7-9 pm, meet in Centennial Lobby

Friday, November 13th from 2-4 pm, meet in Centennial Lobby

Saturday, November 14th from 10am-noon, meet in Centennial Lobby

Step 2—Participate In Group Process

Group Process is the first round of the Residential Leader selection process. During this two hour time, you will be grouped with other men and women applying for the Residential Leader position. You will, as a group/team, experience various scenarios from group consensus building activities to opportunities to discuss or dialogue about important topics ranging from prioritizing a Residential Leader's demands to the role diversity plays in our world. This process will provide Residential Living & Learning an opportunity to get to know you better, in a more relaxed and experiential setting. Come dressed in **casual attire** (shorts, jeans, t-shirts, etc.) as often you may sit on the floor for discussions or even participate in a low-level physical exercise.

On Monday, November 16th, by 5:00 p.m., applicants who will advance to the next step in the selection process will be announced on the Residential Living & Learning website. (<http://www.tarleton.edu/~housing/>).

Step 3—Interview with Residential Coordinator

Applicants who proceed to the next step in the selection process will have a brief interview with their current Residential Coordinator (*off campus students will interview with the Texan Village Residential Coordinator). Applicants will sign up **Tuesday, November 17th—Wednesday, November 18th** at their building's desk to meet with their Residential Coordinator during the following dates:

Upon completion of the interview, each Residential Coordinator will provide applicants with two short essay questions to be completed and submitted when applicant signs up for step four (formal Interview).

On **Friday, December 11th** applicants who will advance to the next step in the selection process will be announced on the Residential Living & Learning website (<http://www.tarleton.edu/~housing/>).

Step 4—Formal Interview with Residential Living & Learning Staff

Applicants who advance from Step 3 will proceed to the final round, a formal interview with two staff members from Residential Living & Learning. Attire should be formal.

From **Tuesday, January 19th through Friday, January 22nd** applicants will sign up for a formal interview at the Residential Living & Learning office. At this time, all essay questions are due.

Step 5—Announcement of Residential Leaders & Alternates
