

DELIVERY & RETURN OF WORK

- Accepted work should be shipped, with **PREPAID RETURN**, to **Dora Lee Langdon Center, 308 E. Pearl St., Granbury, Texas 76048.**
- Crates must be sturdy and reusable with removable top or end fastened with screws. No nails.
- **UPS ground or FEDEX returns preferred**, please enclose prepaid label or account number.
- Shipped work must be received no later than April 1.
- Entries received after deadline will not be judged for awards.
- For your own protection, insure your shipment to and from the Dora Lee Langdon Center
- Accepted work may be hand delivered from noon to 3 p.m. at the A.P. Gordon House on April 1.
- Hand-delivered entries **MUST** be retrieved on April 30 between 4 p.m. – 5 p.m. or by appointment with RBAE director.

LIABILITY

We suggest that artists carry their own insurance. All reasonable care will be taken with slides, CDs and original art. The Langdon Center and the RBAE will not be responsible for loss or damage of any work.

DIGITAL SUBMISSIONS

Submission of digital images of your work on a single CD will be accepted:

Please provide images **at highest resolution** your digital camera will provide. Images should be no smaller than 4" x 5" at 300 dpi (around 4MB in size when saved as TIF, 2MB when saved as JPEG). If available, Camera Raw is the best file format choice. If it is necessary to capture digital images to JPEG, choose the **maximum resolution**. If scanning images, scan at highest optical resolution possible and save files with no file compression. **Final scans should not be any smaller than sizes indicated above.**

Name your images in the following manner: Last name, underscore, first initial, underscore, title, file extension. Example: **Smith_J_MidnightBlue.jpg**

Burn CDs as cross-platform (to be read under MacOS or Windows).

Please name your CD in the following manner: Last name, underscore, first name. Example: **Smith_Jane**

CDs only – No other type of media will be accepted. No CD will be returned unless the correct postage and envelope is provided.

Submissions may be emailed with approval. Email the RBAE director at langdoncenter@gmail.com for instructions before sending images.

SALES

All work entered must be available for sale. Dora Lee Langdon Center will conduct all sales during the exhibition. Price, not including tax, must be listed on entry card. A 25% commission is collected upon sale.

April 30	Show closes. Hand-delivered works to be retrieved between 4 p.m. to 5 p.m. only.

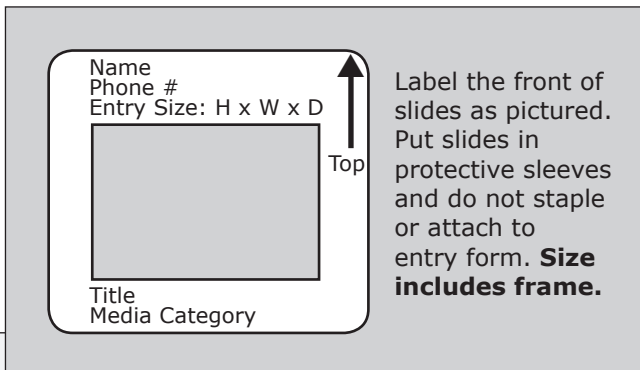

ELIGIBILITY & REQUIREMENTS

- **All media will be considered.** This could include, but not be limited to, water media, oil, acrylic, pastel, mixed-media, photography, printmaking, graphics, collage, 3-dimensional, fabric, etc.
- Open to all artists 18 years of age and older.
- Entries must be original, unpublished and executed within the last two years.
- Entries must not have been previously exhibited in the RBAE.
- Works must be suitably framed with wire hangers (**no saw-tooth hangers**) and be thoroughly dry.
- Plexiglas only, with the exception of pastels (non-soluble surface need not be glazed).
- Framed & hung works may not exceed 50" in any direction, including frame, nor weigh more than 12 lbs.
- 3-dimensional works may require artist or agent installation followed by height regulation and may not exceed 60" in any direction.
- Any work differing from slide or digital image will be disqualified.
- The RBAE reserves the right to refuse any work submitted.
- **All accepted works must remain at the Langdon Center for the duration of the judging and exhibit.**

The exhibition is supported by the Granbury Arts Alliance, the City of Granbury, Tarleton State University, and numerous local and regional businesses. The coordinators of this event plan to create an atmosphere that will inspire, educate and entertain as well as attract quality art and discriminating buyers.

THE DORA LEE LANGDON CULTURAL CENTER

The Dora Lee Langdon Cultural and Education Center is nestled one block off Granbury's historic square in the Brazos River Valley and serves as a focal point for fine arts in the Lake Granbury area. The Langdon Center serves as the cultural and educational hub of the downtown area in cooperation with the City of Granbury and Tarleton State University.

GRANBURY ARTS ALLIANCE
