Supplies you should keep in your vehicle.

Flashlight “that works”

Duck tape

Blanket

Paper Towels

Gloves

“Call Police” sign

Cell Phone

Check these before traveling:

Oil level

Water– in radiator, refill with anti-freeze fluid.

Engine Belt-check for cracks or missing pieces.

Battery- terminals are clean and well connected.

Air pressure in tires, the right amount.

Power Steering fluid is full.

Gas– a full tank.

All these items are important to check before you start on a trip and will save you money and time.

It’s on the back of your driver’s license.

Make sure you have a spare tire and know where it is. The spare should be aired up. Make sure your vehicle has a jack and you know where it is or do you need to get one and keep it in your vehicle.

Knowing how to use an air gauge is very important. Tires with the right amount of air can save you gas. Under inflated tires are dangerous, and can cause the steering to become difficult.

Check with your parents to see if your vehicle has road side assistance service.

Have your cell phoned charged and a car charger with you when you travel. Call when you start your trip. Advise what route you are taking.
