Student must:

- Have earned a master's degree in order to receive a certificate.
- Consult with the graduate advisor to complete a separate degree plan.
- Hold a valid teacher certificate and two years of teaching experience (K-12).
- Be admitted to the Professional Counselor Program.

For Emergency Permit the student must:

- Complete 12 hours if already holds the Master's degree, including CPSY 550 or equivalent.
- Complete 24 hours if does not hold the Master's degree, including CPSY 550 or equivalent.
- For the Emergency Permit, the student must have **three** years of teaching experience.

Additional Information:

- For full certificate, students with a master's degree from another university in counseling, counseling psychology, or clinical psychology, and in some cases educational psychology, must complete a minimum of 18 hours at Tarleton. Advisors will specify courses that may be transferred.
- All transferred coursework must fall within specified time limits. Consult advisor for exact limits.
- Master's degree in "counseling or related field" required for Licensed Professional Counselor license.
- *** indicates EDU 502 may be rejected by Board of Examiners of Licensed Professional Counselors.

- CPSY 550 or equivalent is prerequisite for all additional CPSY, CNSL, and PSY classes.
- Courses marked with * are prerequisites for internship.
- CPSY 553 is prerequisite for CPSY 557.
