

Medical: JH BAND

1. 24 hour medical assistance is available for all participants.
2. Tarleton Fine Arts Summer Camps provides transportation for camp related injuries.
3. Parents/Guardians are responsible for seeking medical treatment for non-camp related injuries and illness. However, in the event a parent/guardian is unable to attend to a camper in a timely manner the Fine Arts Summer Camps will provide transportation and seek medical treatment for illness or non-camp related injuries.
4. Any participant unable to participate in camp activities due to illness or injury **will be sent home!**

Medications:

1. Campers are responsible for the security of and taking individual medications, both prescription and over the counter.
2. A nurse is on-call 24 hours for assistance with other medical issues.

Insurance:

1. Tarleton State University Fine Arts Summer Camps provides a secondary insurance policy on all camp participants. This policy is intended to assist participants with medical coverage, but is not a primary insurance policy.
2. Participants/Parents/Guardians are responsible for any and all medical costs up to, but not limited to; ambulance charges, x-rays and other diagnostic test, prescriptions, any and all physician's charges, any and all emergency room charges, any and all clinic charges.
3. The Tarleton insurance policy covers charges related to injuries incurred during camp participation ONLY.
4. Please note: Illness is not covered by the Tarleton insurance policy.

To File a Claim:

1. Is it is the sole responsibility of the participant/parent/guardian to file a claim in a timely fashion.
2. ALL claims must be filed no later than 90 days from the date of injury.

3. Insurance forms (form B) will be mailed to the parent/guardian/participant by the director of summer camps.
4. Participant/parent/guardian should complete the form and return to the address listed on the form.
5. Address any questions concerning a claim to the address and phone number on the form. DO NOT contact the office of summer camps.
