

Medical and Insurance

Medical:

1. 24 hour medical assistance is available for all participants.
2. Tarleton Fine Arts Summer Camps provides transportation for camp related injuries.
3. Sponsors/Coaches should provide transportation for non-camp related injuries and illness. However, in the event a squad has no available transportation, Fine Arts Summer Camps will provide transportation.
4. Sponsors/Coaches are responsible for taking/remaining with campers during medical treatment.
5. Any participant unable to participate in camp activities due to illness or injury will be sent home!
6. Sponsors/Coaches should contact camper's parent in a timely fashion in regards to medical treatment/needs.

Insurance:

1. Tarleton State University Fine Arts Summer Camps provides a secondary insurance policy on all camp participants. This policy is intended to assist participants with medical coverage, but is not a primary insurance policy.
2. Participants/Parents/Guardians are responsible for any and all medical costs up to, but not limited to, ambulance charges, x-rays and other diagnostic test, prescriptions, any and all physician's charges, any and all emergency room charges, any and all clinic charges.
3. Tarleton's insurance policy covers charges related to injuries incurred during camp participation ONLY.
4. Please note: Illness is not covered by the Tarleton insurance policy.

To File a Claim:

1. **It is the sole responsibility of the participant/parent/guardian to file a claim in a timely fashion.**
2. **ALL claims must be filed no later than 90 days from the date of injury.**
3. Insurance forms (form B) will be mailed to the parent/guardian/participant by the director of summer camps.
4. Participant/parent/guardian should complete the form and return to the address listed on the form.
5. Address any questions concerning a claim to the address and phone number on the form. DO NOT contact the office of summer camps.
