WHAT WILL YOU NEED TO DO FOR EXPEDITION #2?

Expedition #2 consists of you completing the following:

- ◆ Activate your LifeKnowledge Online Account

- ◆ Download the LifeKnowledge Online User Manual
 - The User Manual can be found on the LifeKnowledge Online homepage (<http://www.agedlearning.com>) or at the Delta Conference homepage.
- ◆ Assign yourself the "Relationships Pretest" under the Precept Indicator Assessment Tab.
 - Directions are located in the User Manual
 - The pretest is 25 questions.
- ◆ Login using your student name and password and complete the "Relationships Pretest."
 - Note: This screen will look similar to the "teacher" screen, however, the assigned pretest will appear in the middle of the page.

- ◆ Once completed, log back in as a teacher and print out the following reports: Assessment Overview, Coaching Report and Gradebook Report.

 - If you are unfamiliar with LifeKnowledge, be sure to familiarize yourself with the remainder of the tools and materials before **June 15, 2009**.
