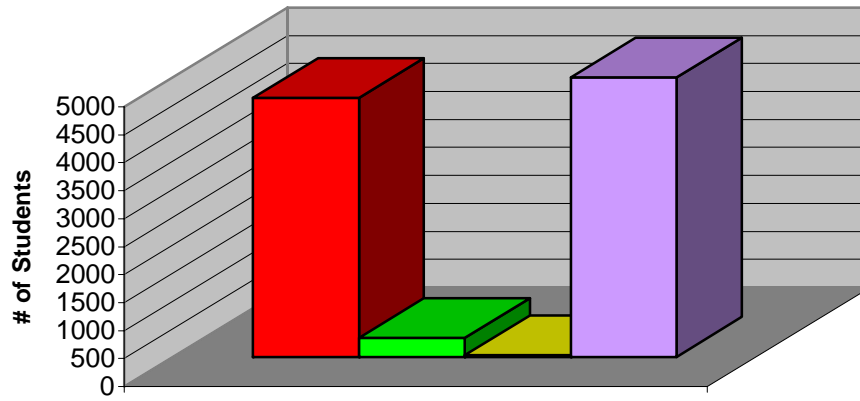

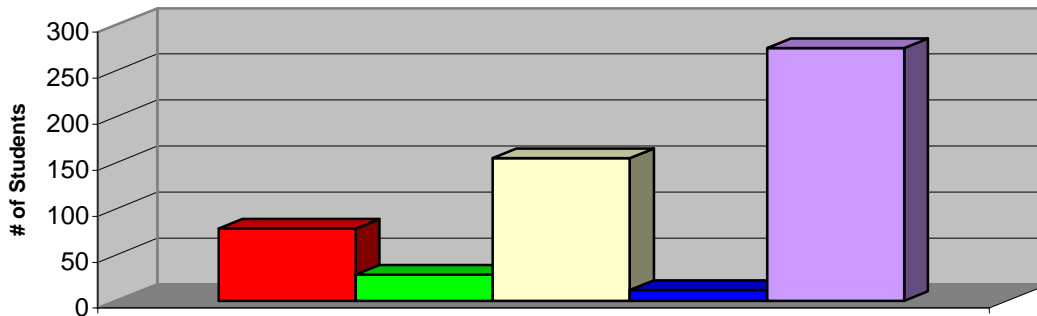

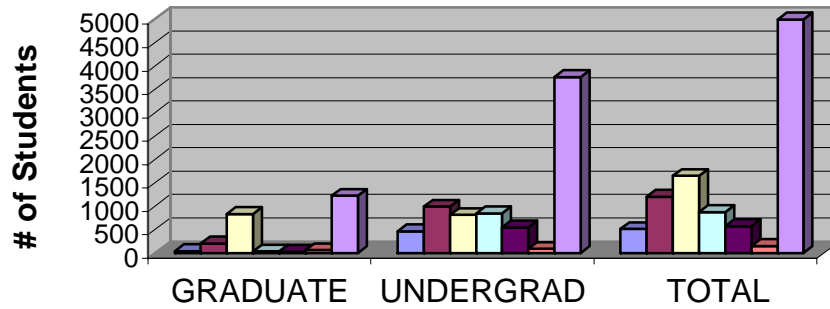

Student Headcount by Transfer College Type

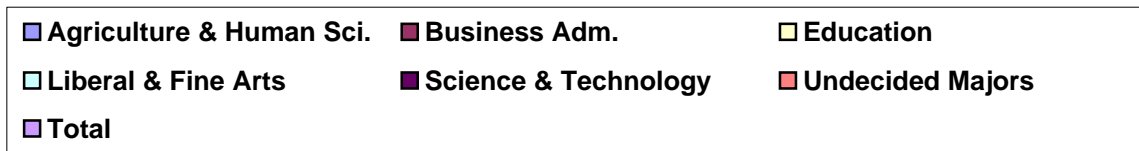

All Tarleton State University Student Headcount by College Summer 2004



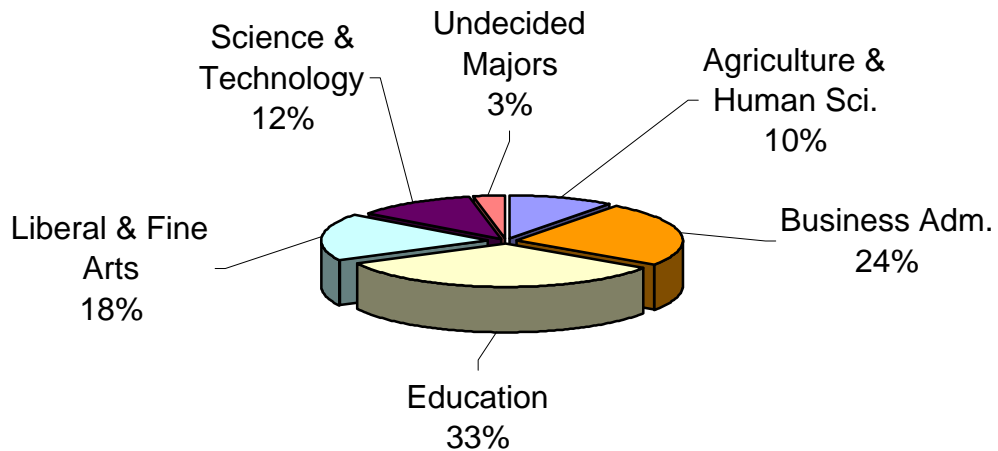

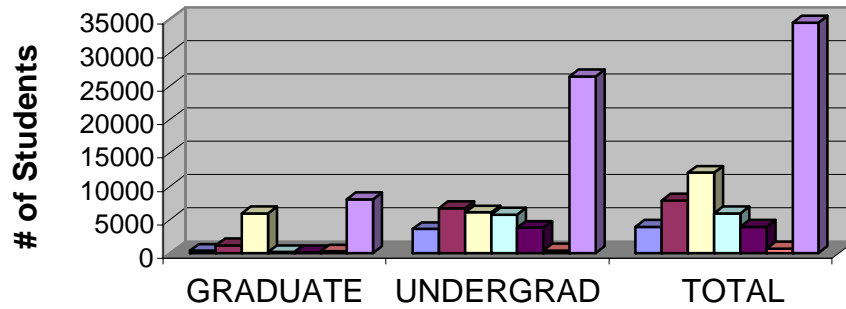

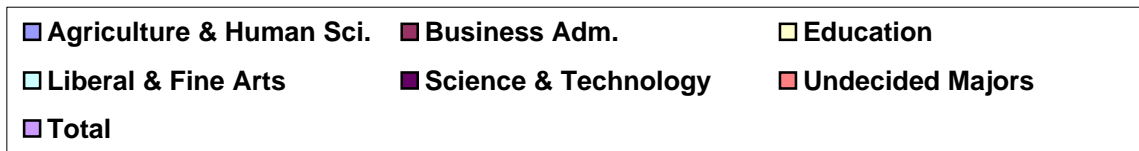
2004 Summer Headcount By College



All Tarleton State University Semester Credit Hours Taken by Majors Within Colleges Summer 2004



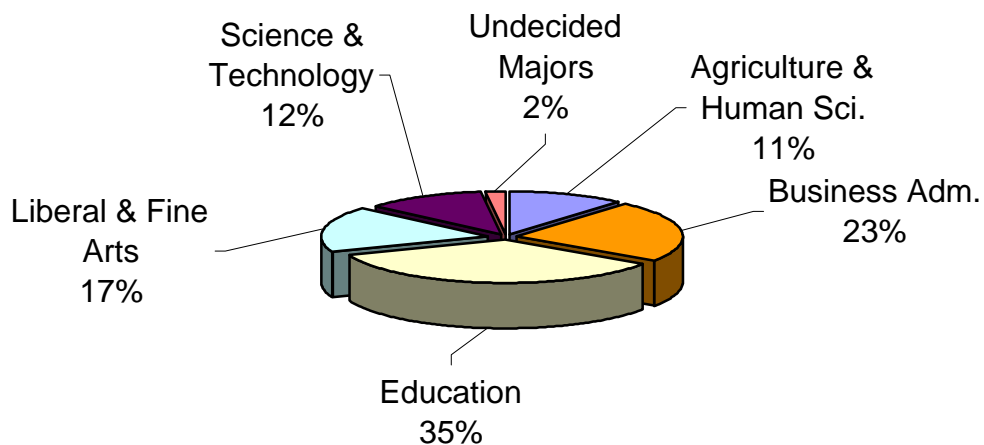

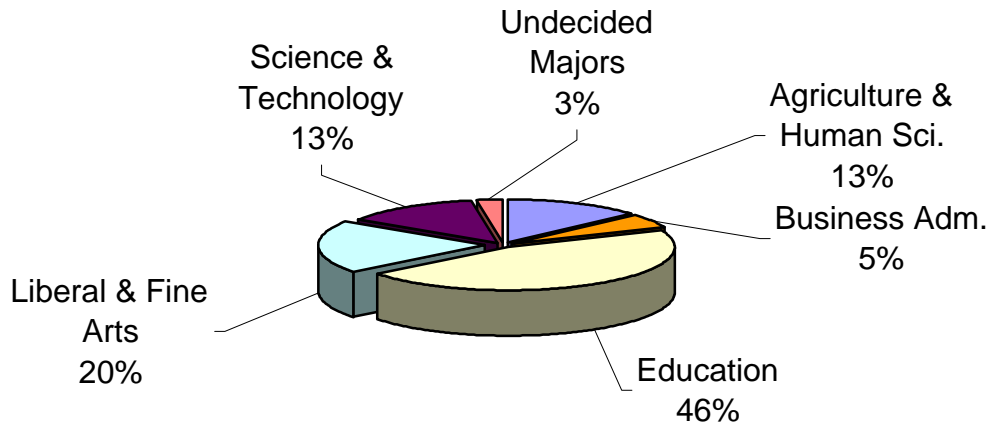

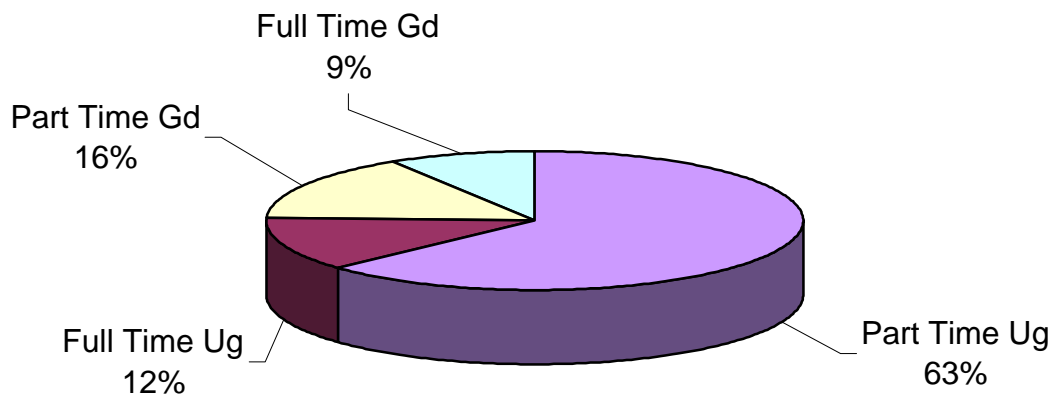

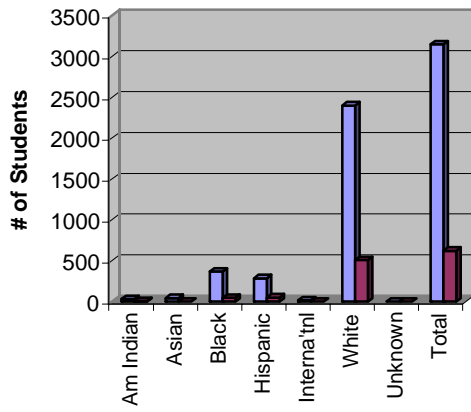

All Tarleton State University Part-Time/Full Time Headcount by Ethnicity and Status

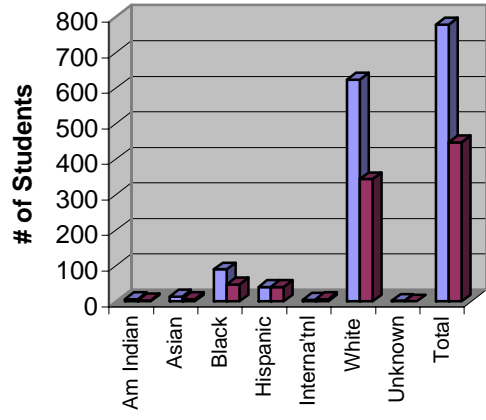

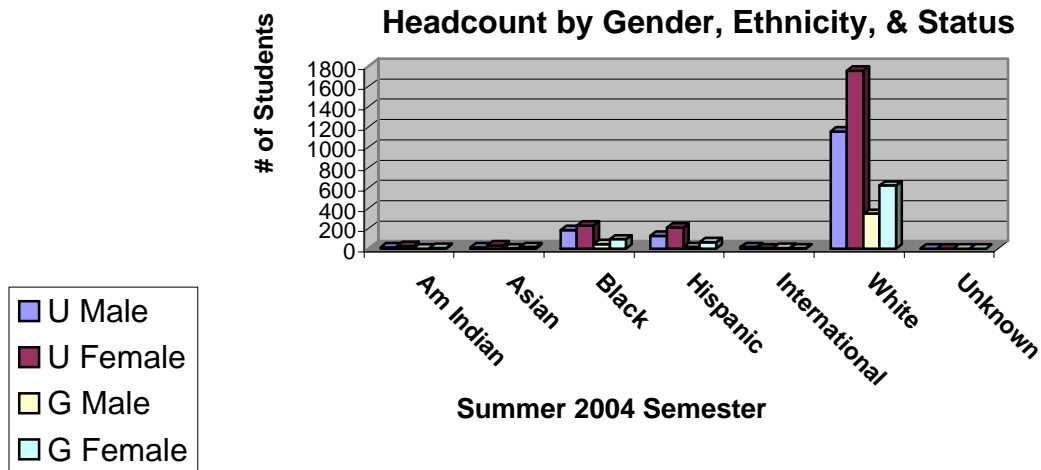

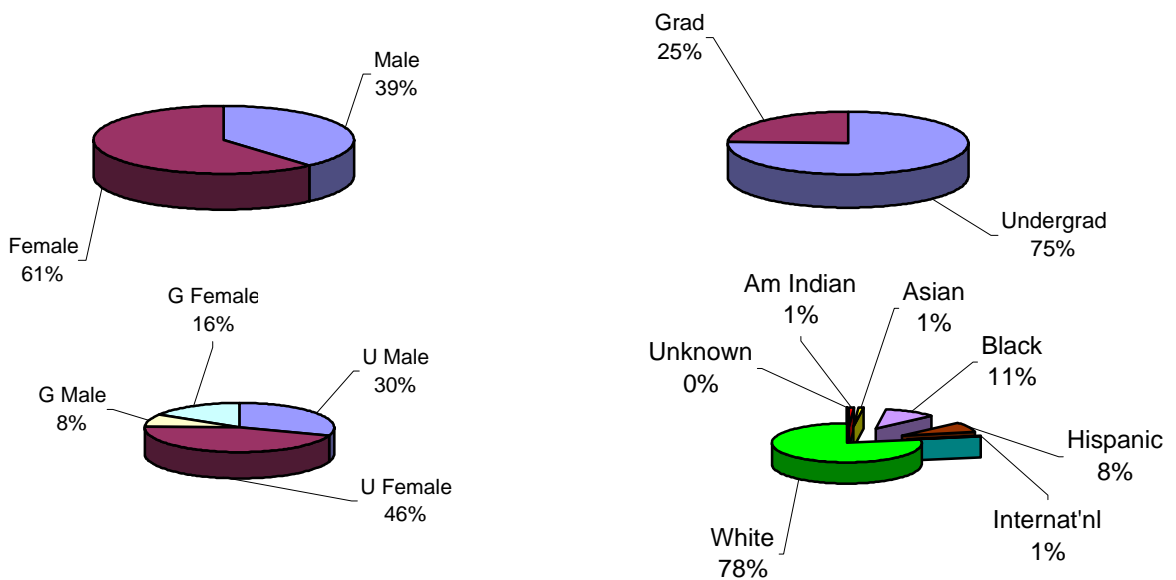

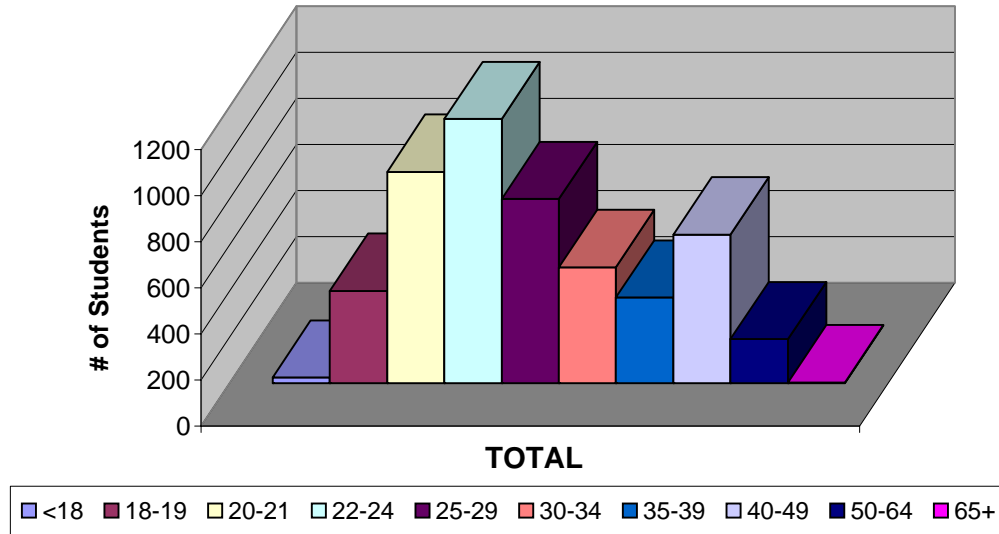

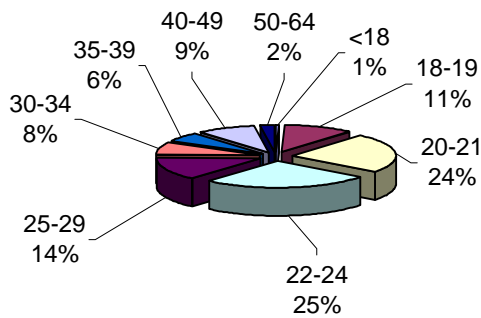
