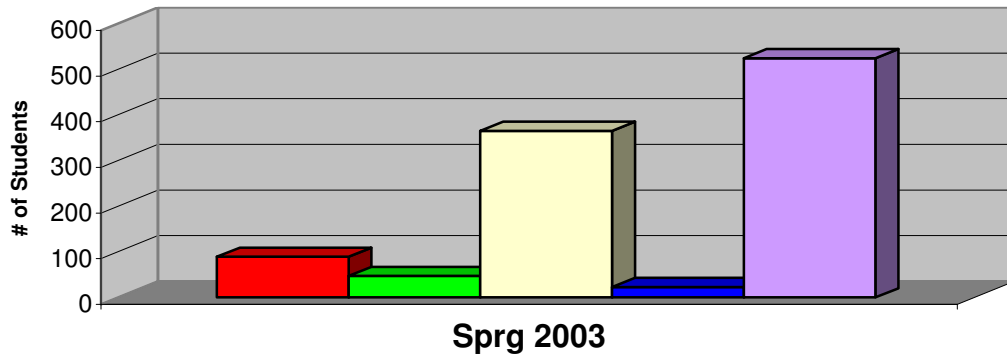

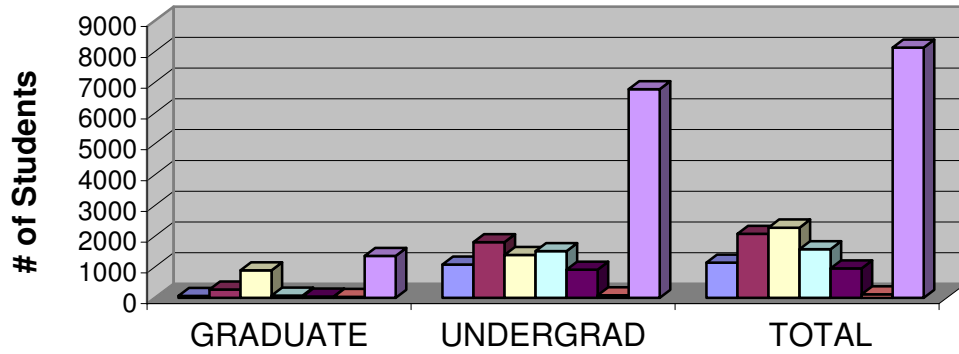

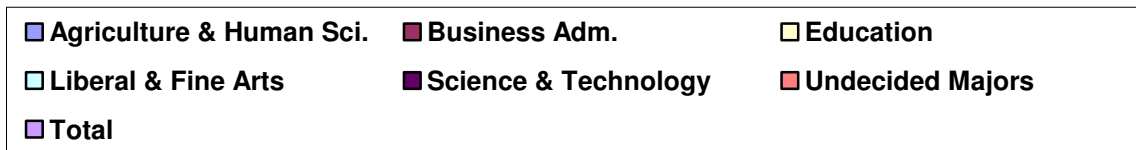
Student Headcount by Transfer College Type

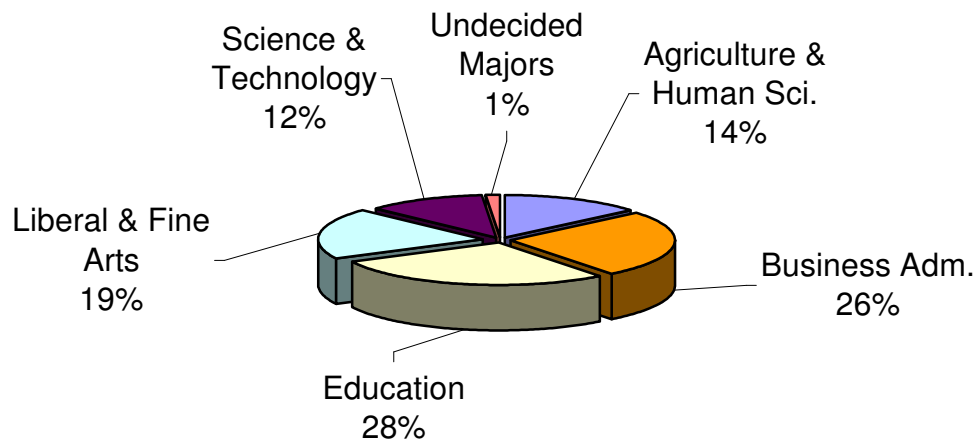

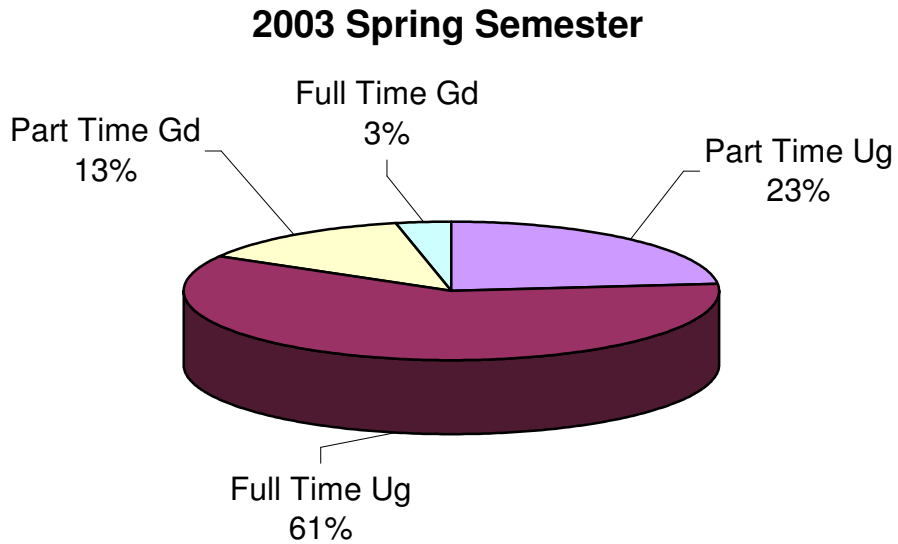

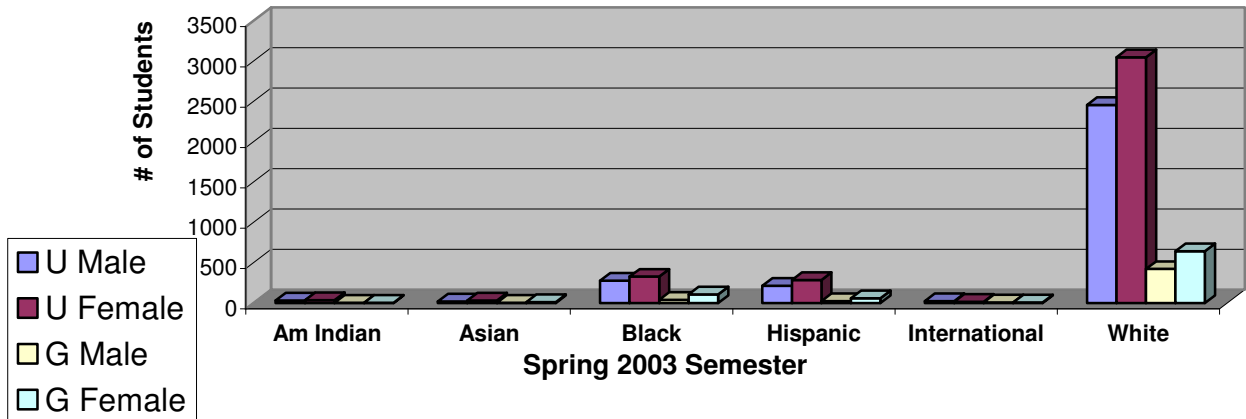

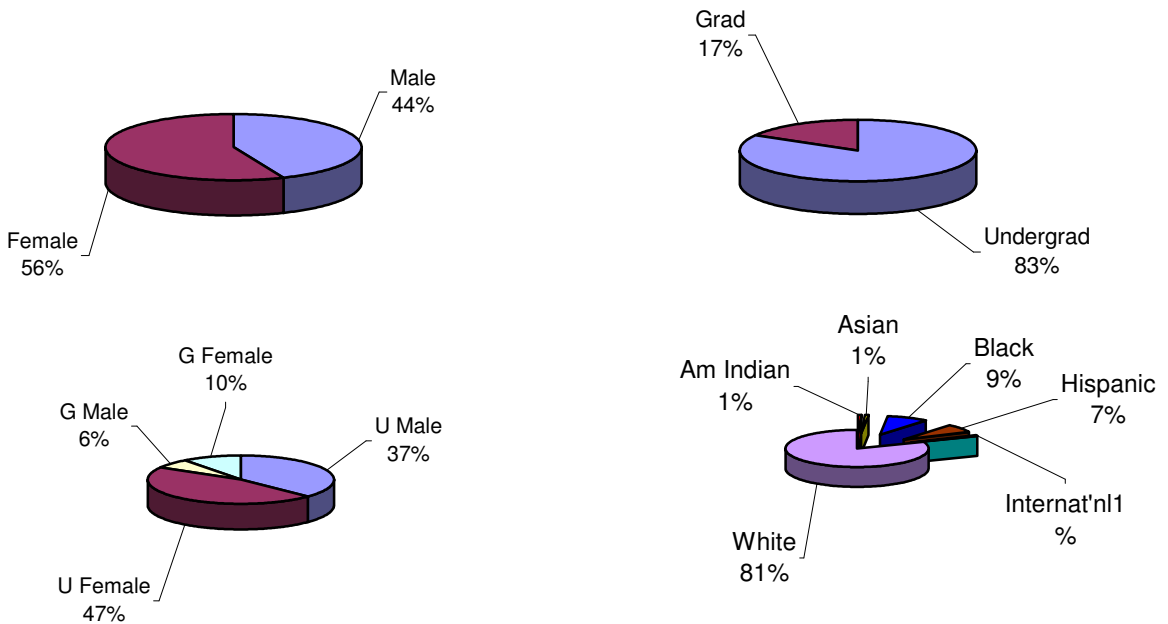

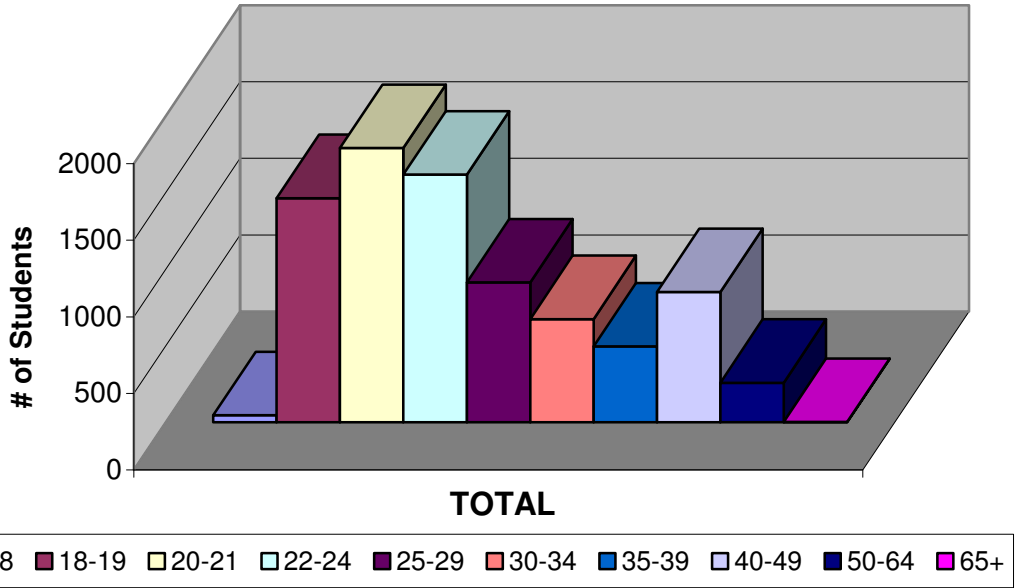

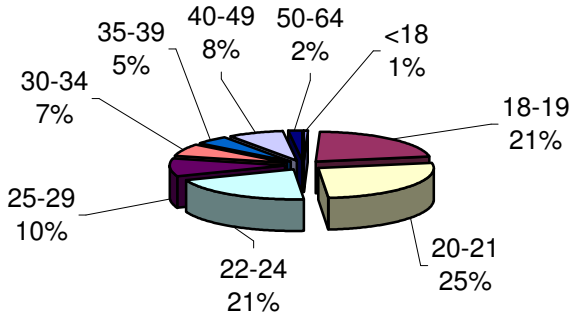
Age Distribution of All Tarleton State University Students
