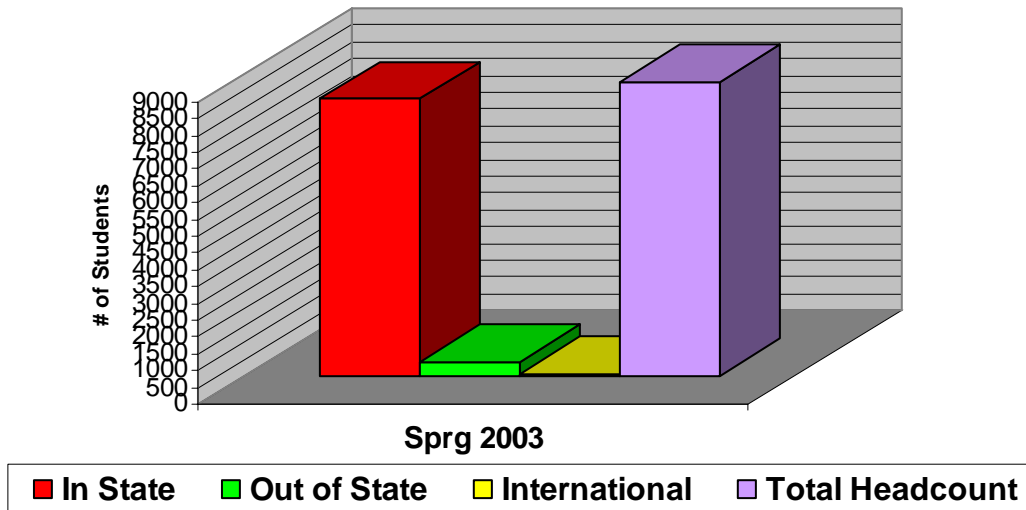

**Student Headcount by Geographical Origins**



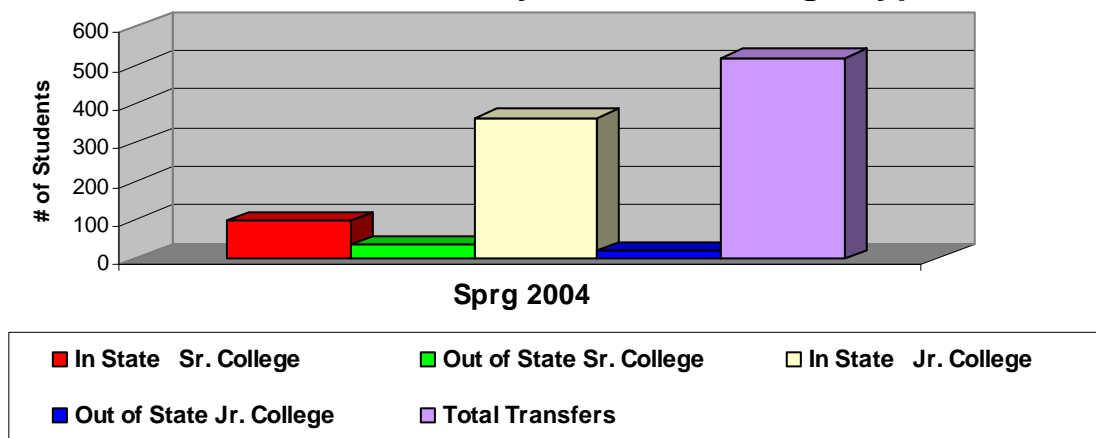

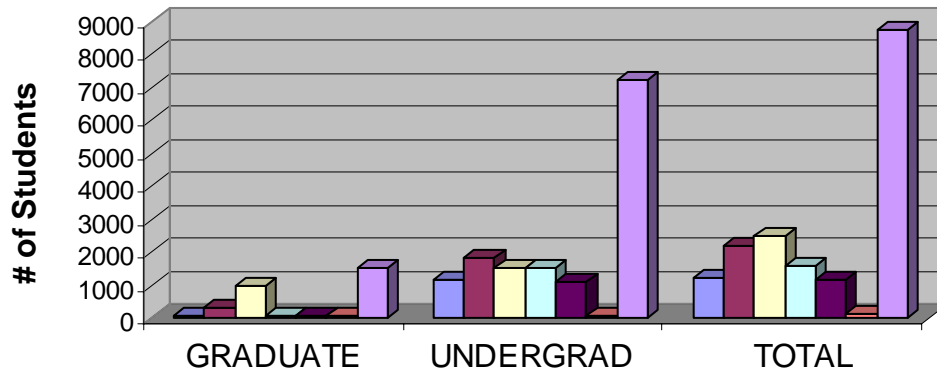

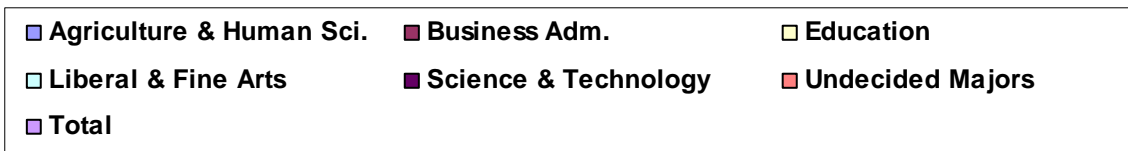
**Student Headcount by Transfer College Type**



## All Tarleton State University Student Headcount by College SPRING 2004



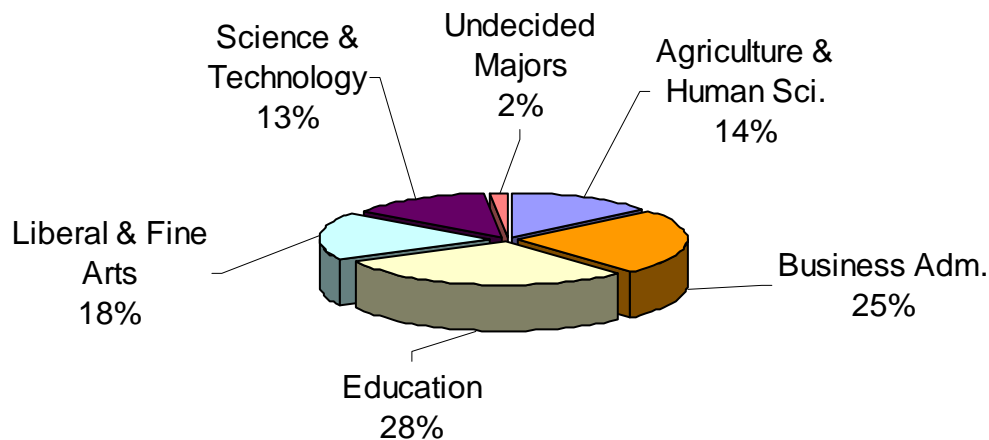

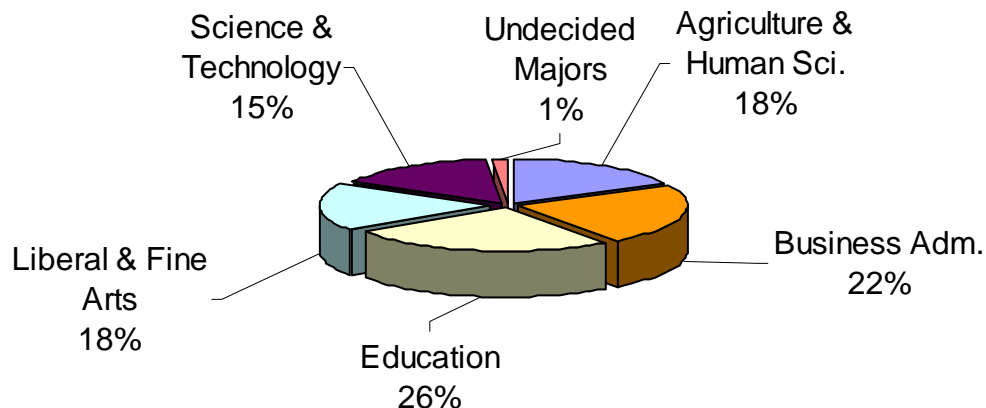

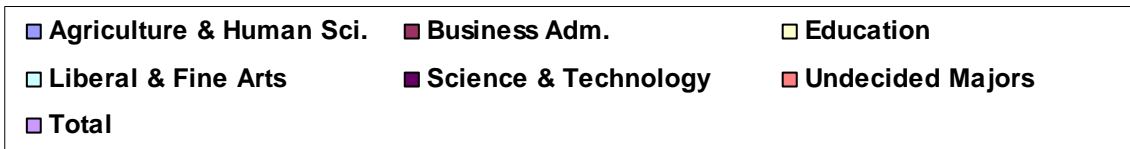
### 2004 Spring Semester Credit Hrs. By College

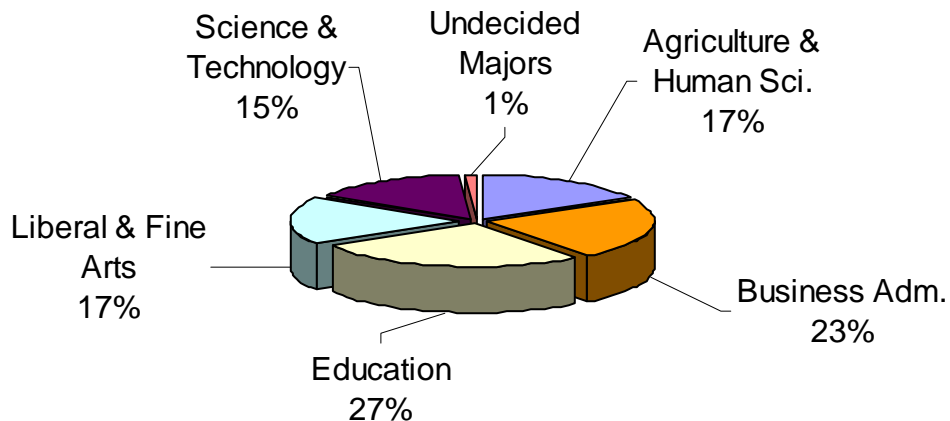

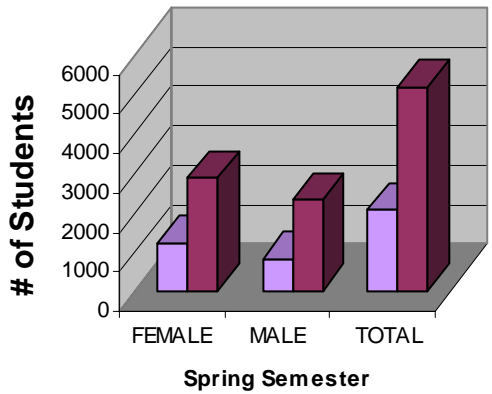

**2004 Semester FTE By College**



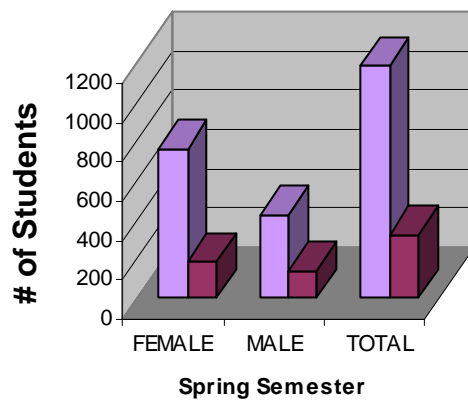

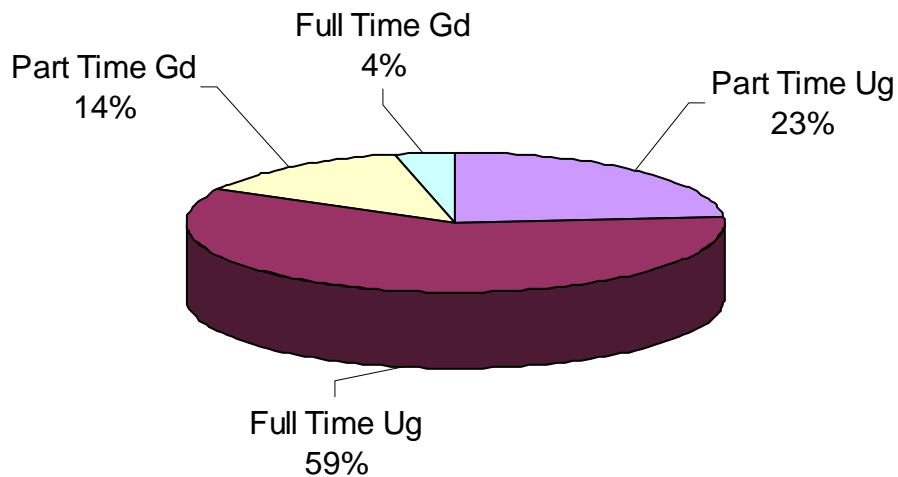

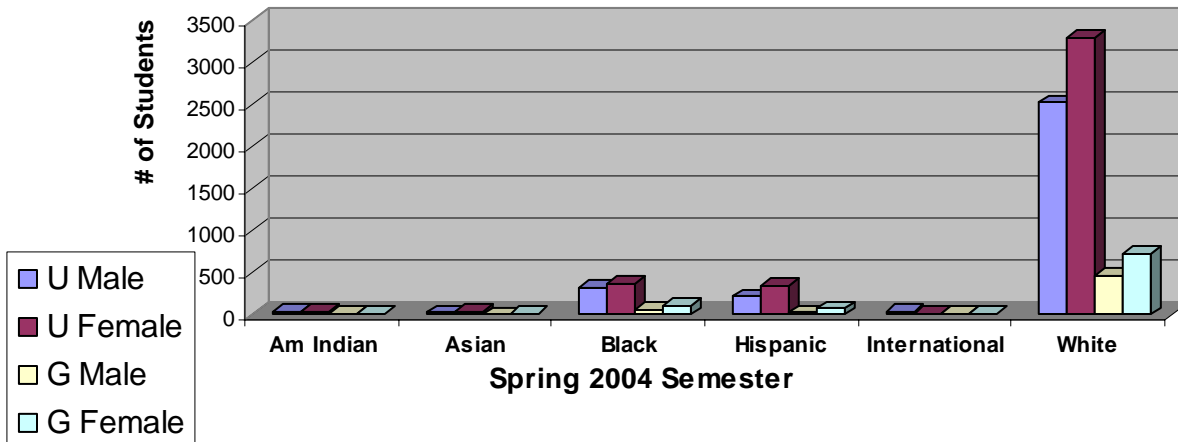

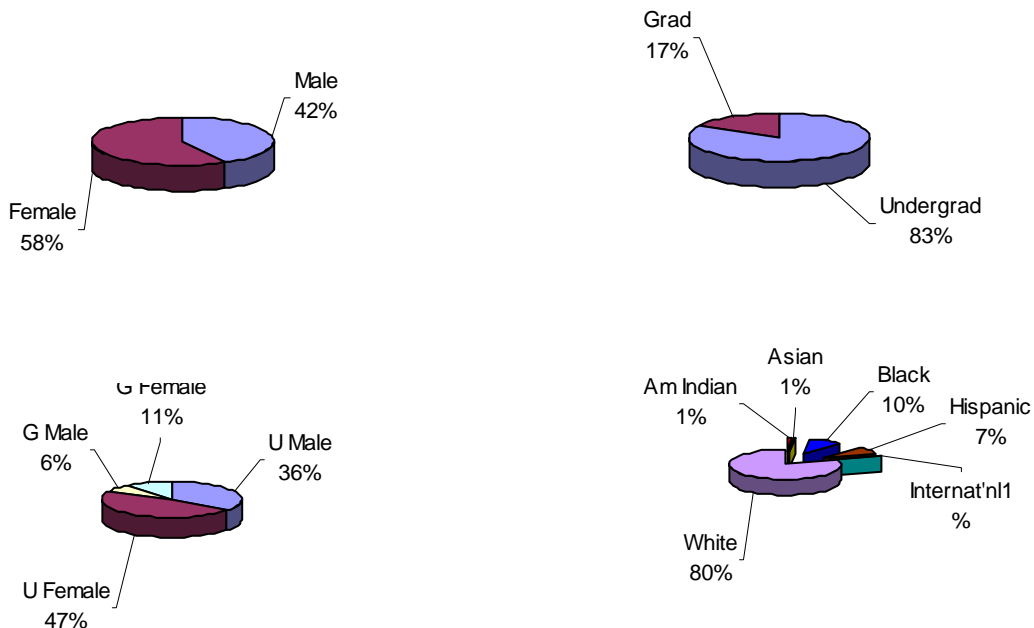

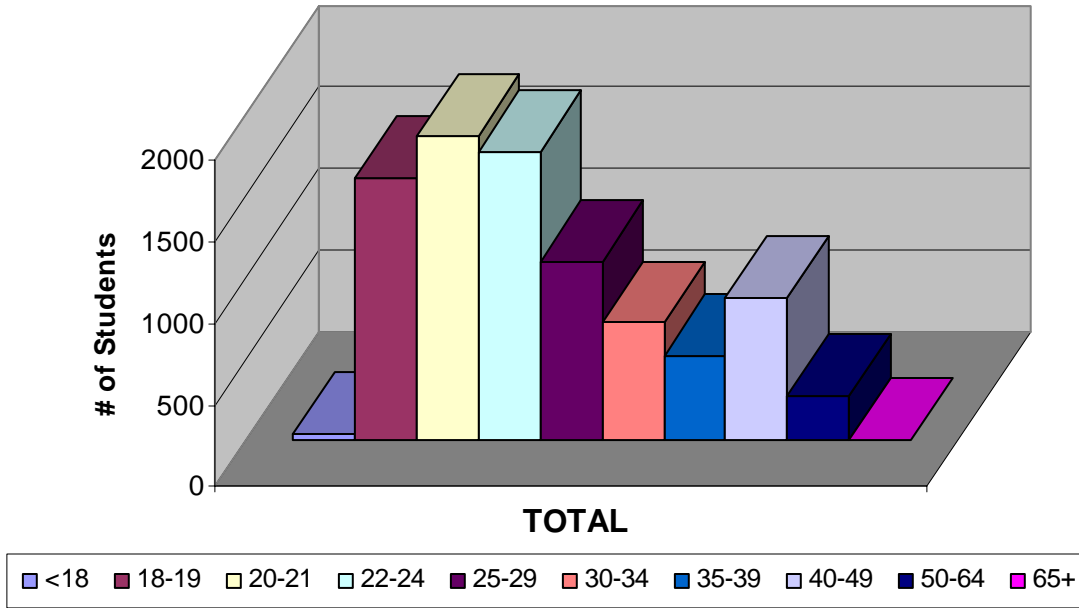

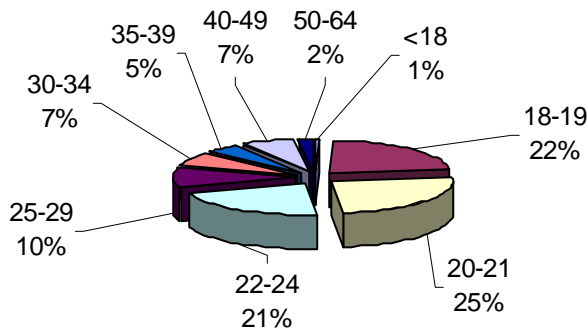
