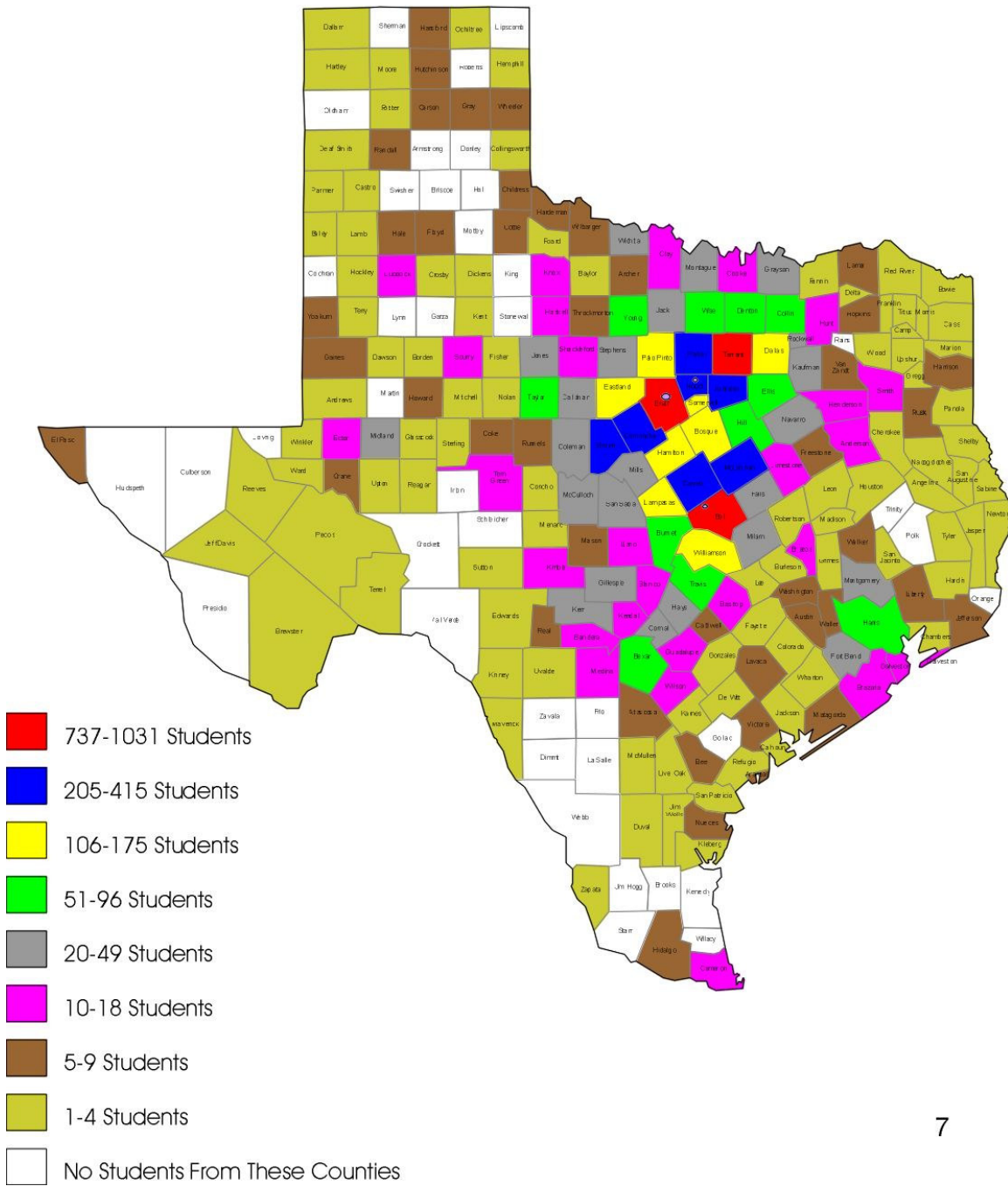

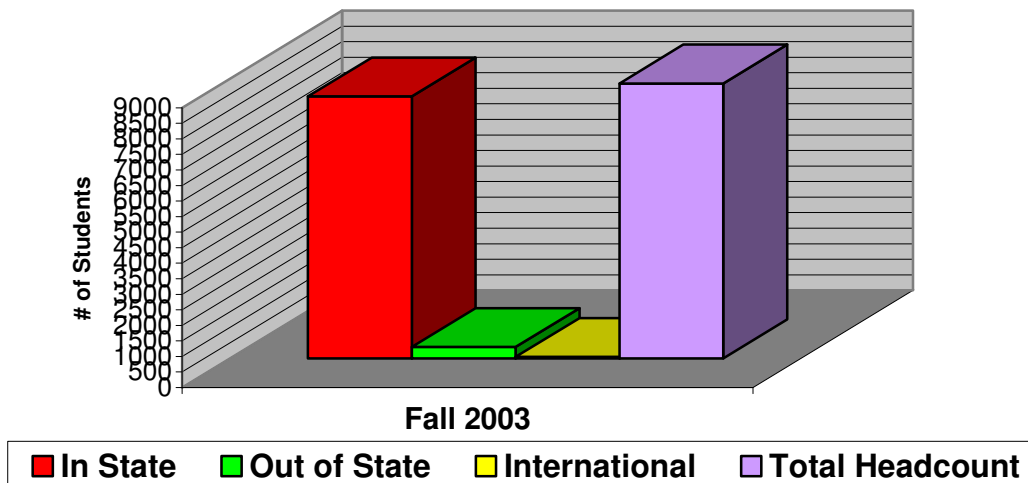

Student Headcount by Geographical Origins



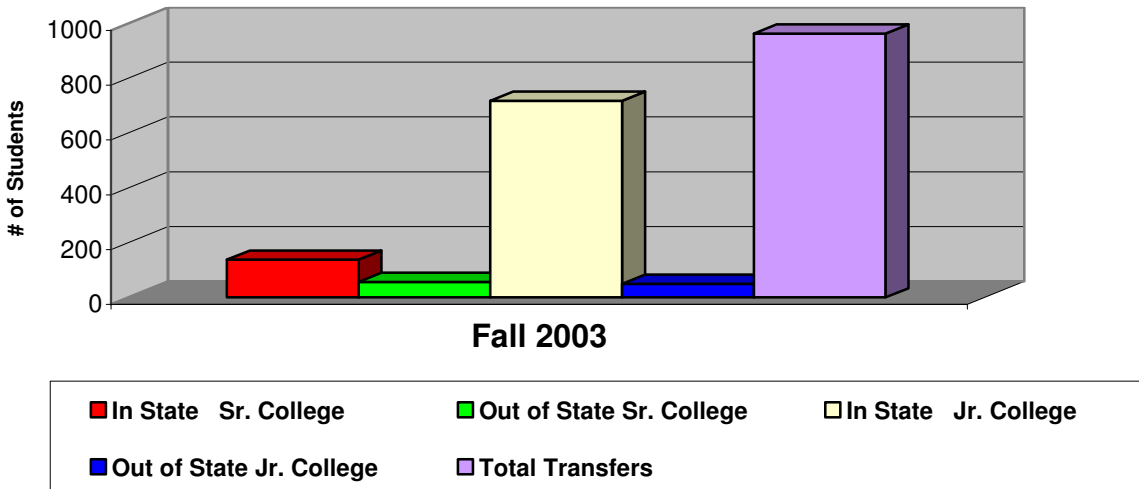

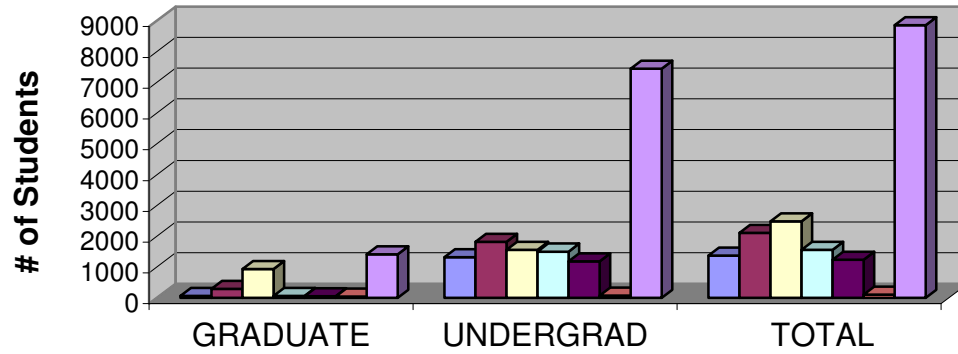

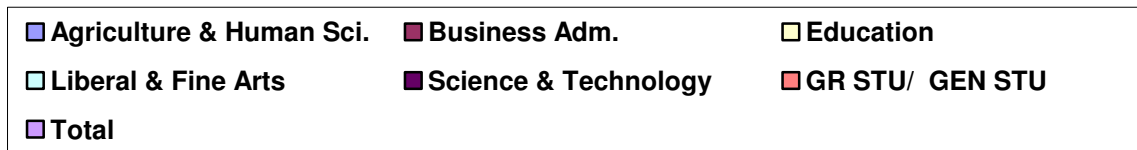
Student Headcount by Transfer College Type



Tarleton State University – All Locations Student Headcount by College Fall 2003



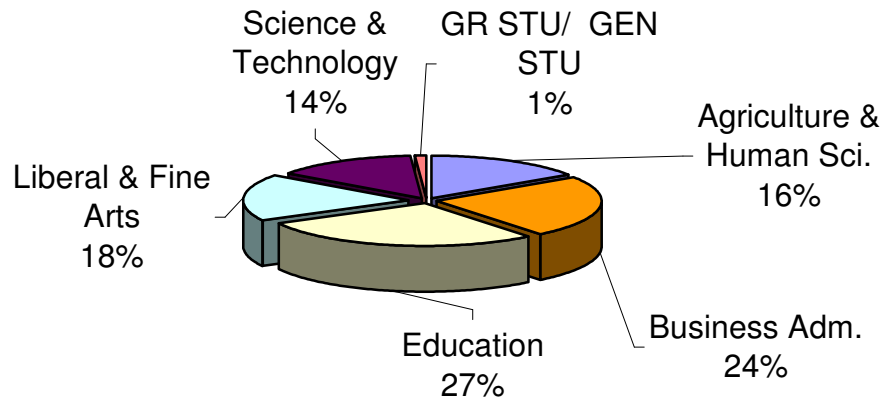

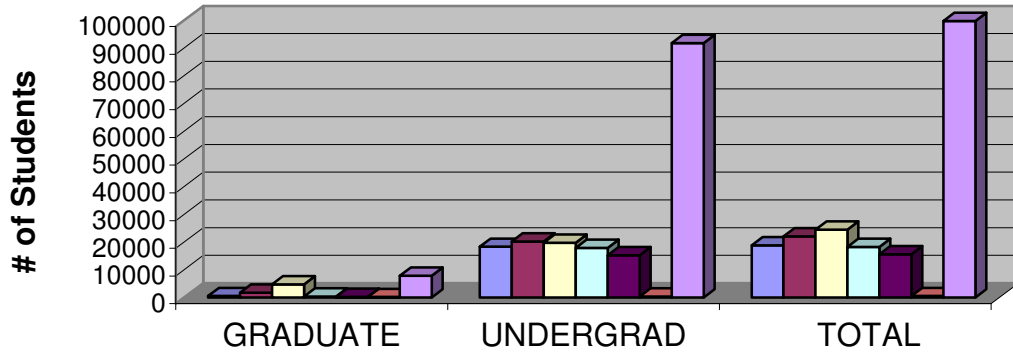

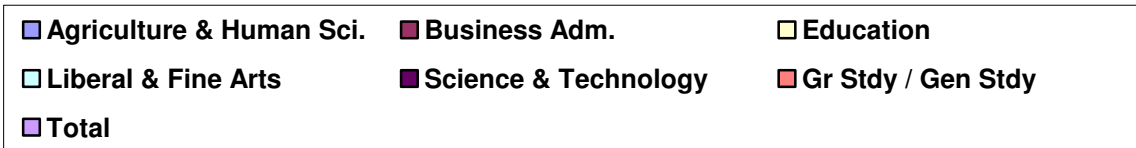

All Tarleton State University Semester Credit Hours by College Fall 2003



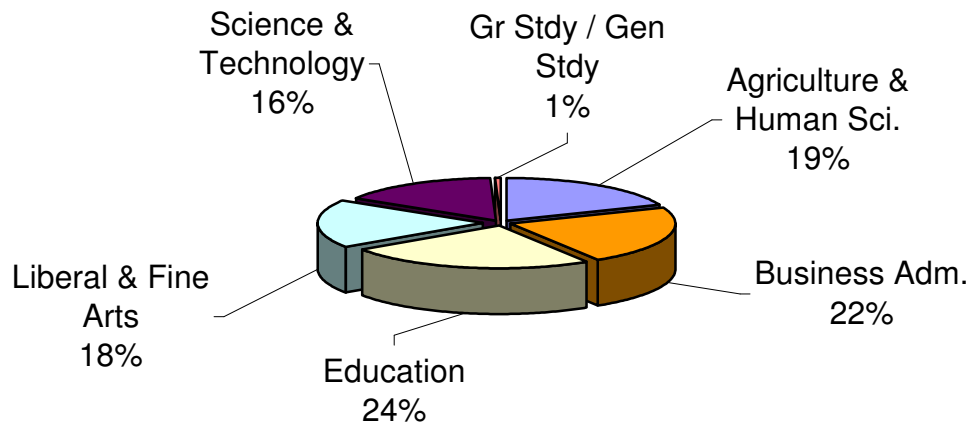

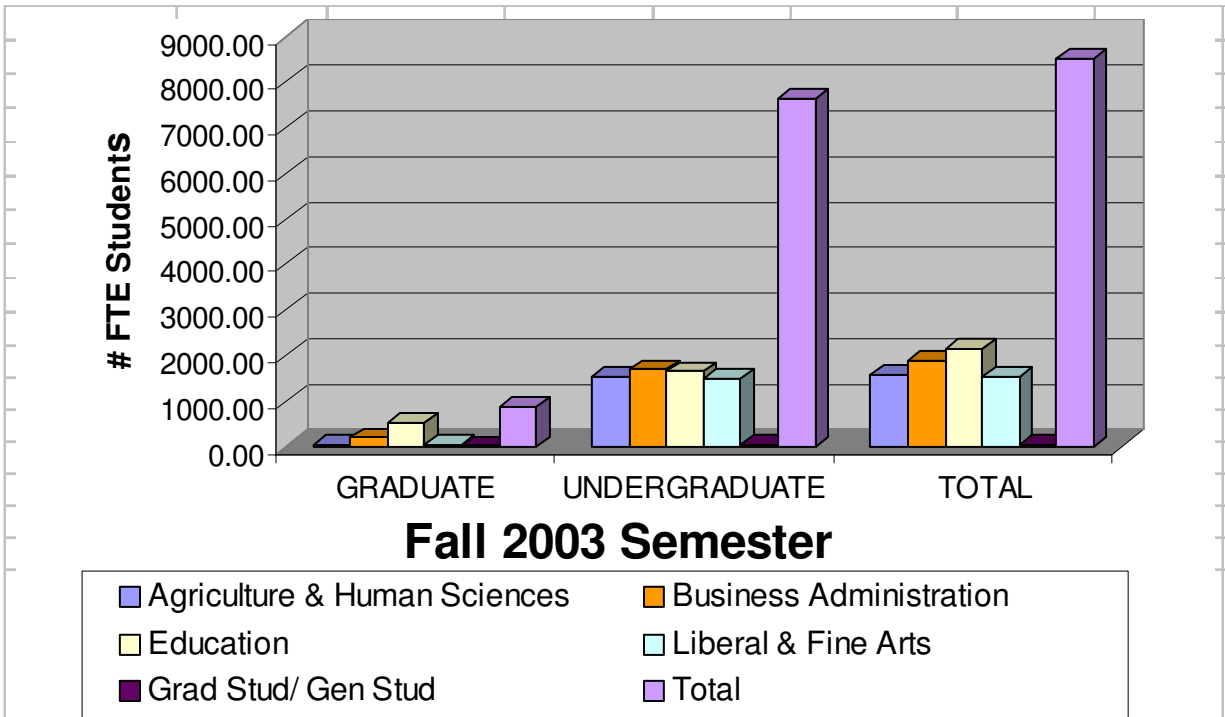

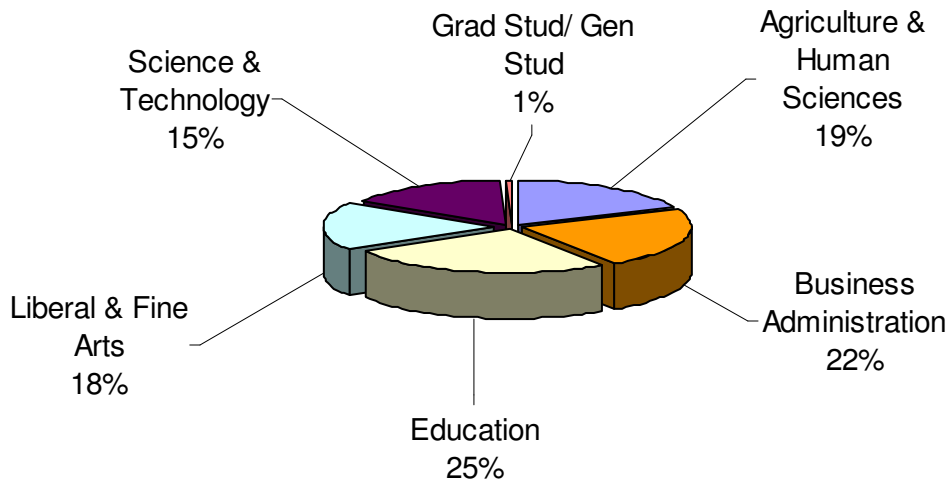

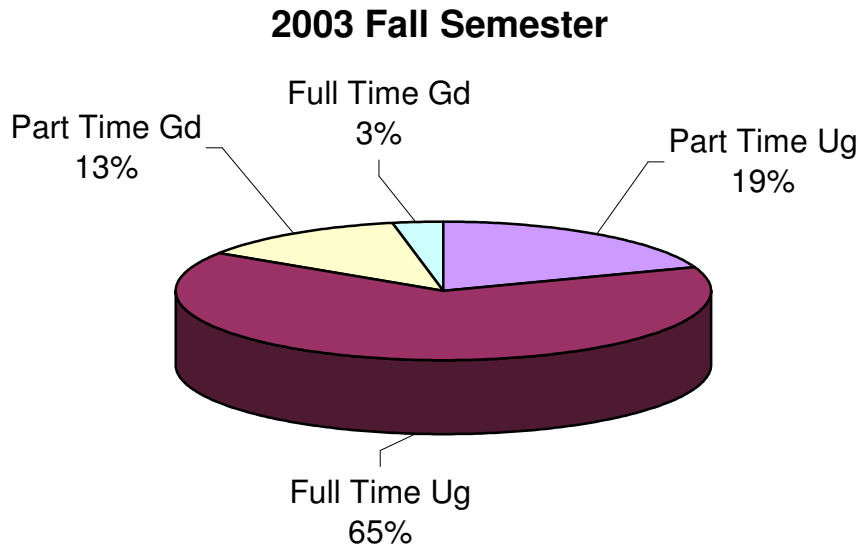
2003 Fall Semester FTE By College



Tarleton State University – All Locations Part Time/Full Time Headcount by Gender and Status – Fall 2003



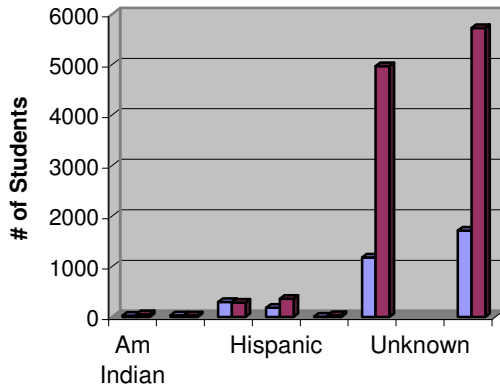

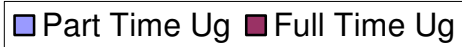

Part Time/Full Time Headcount by Ethnicity and Status – Fall 2003

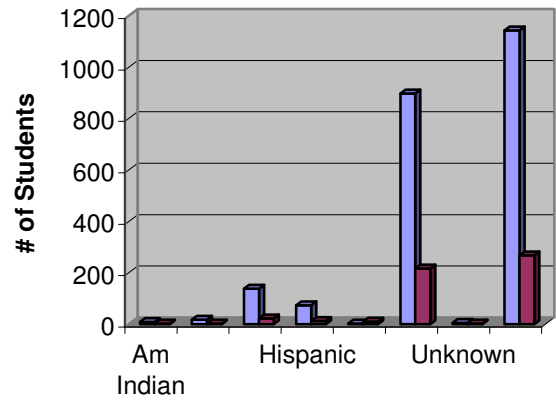

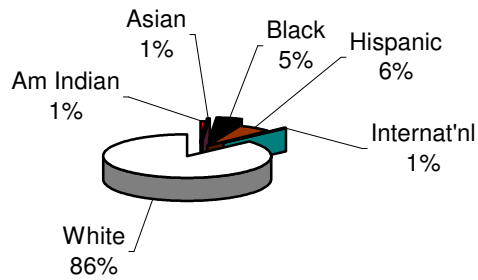

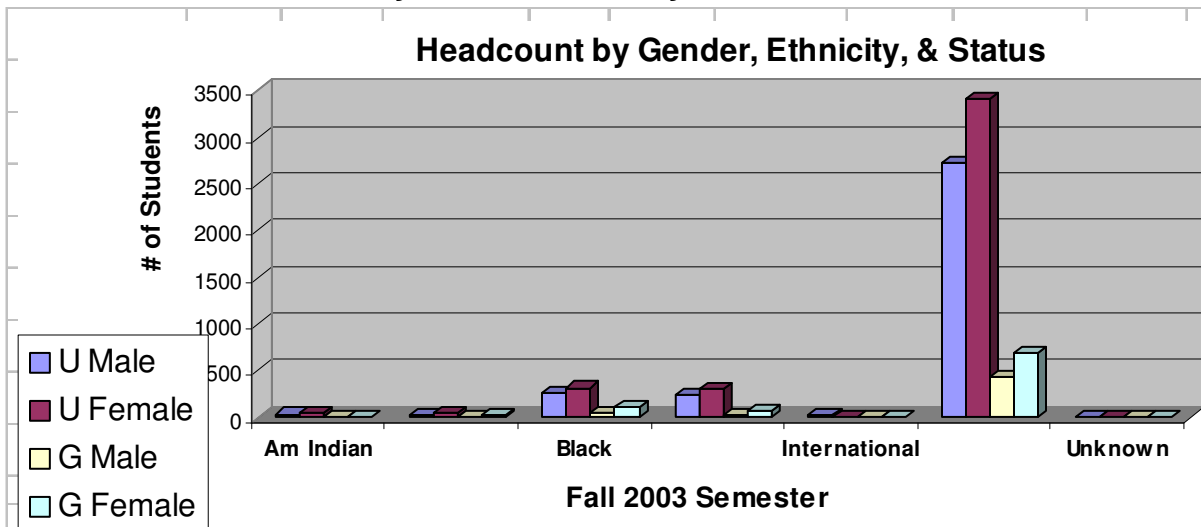

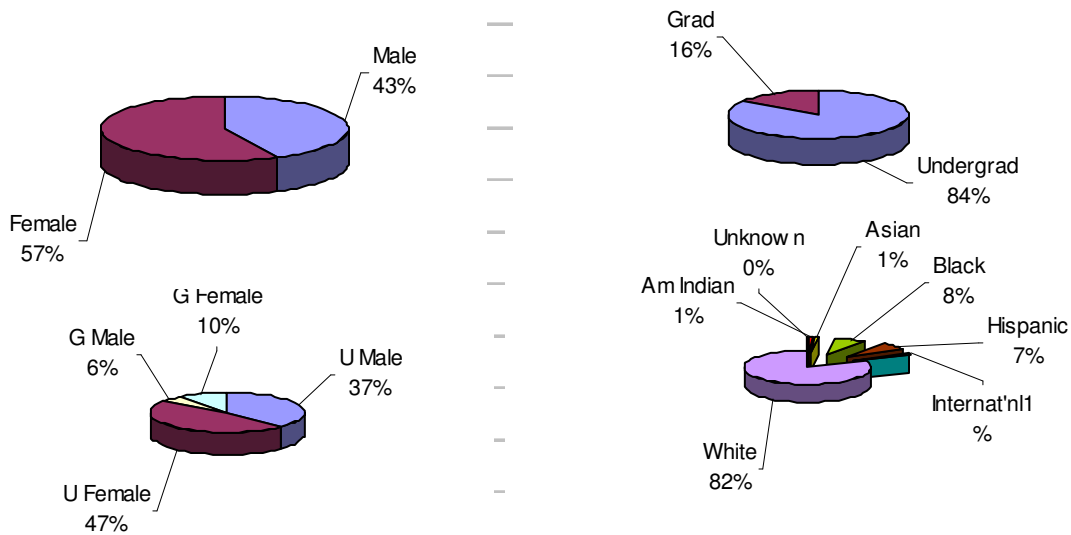

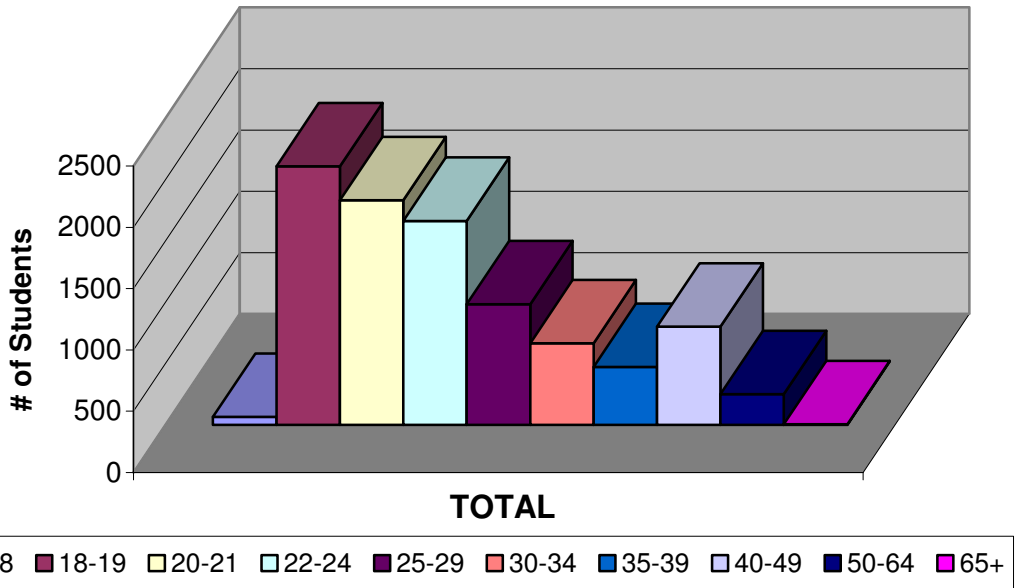

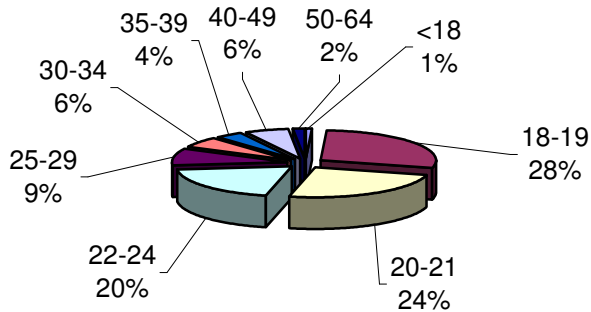
