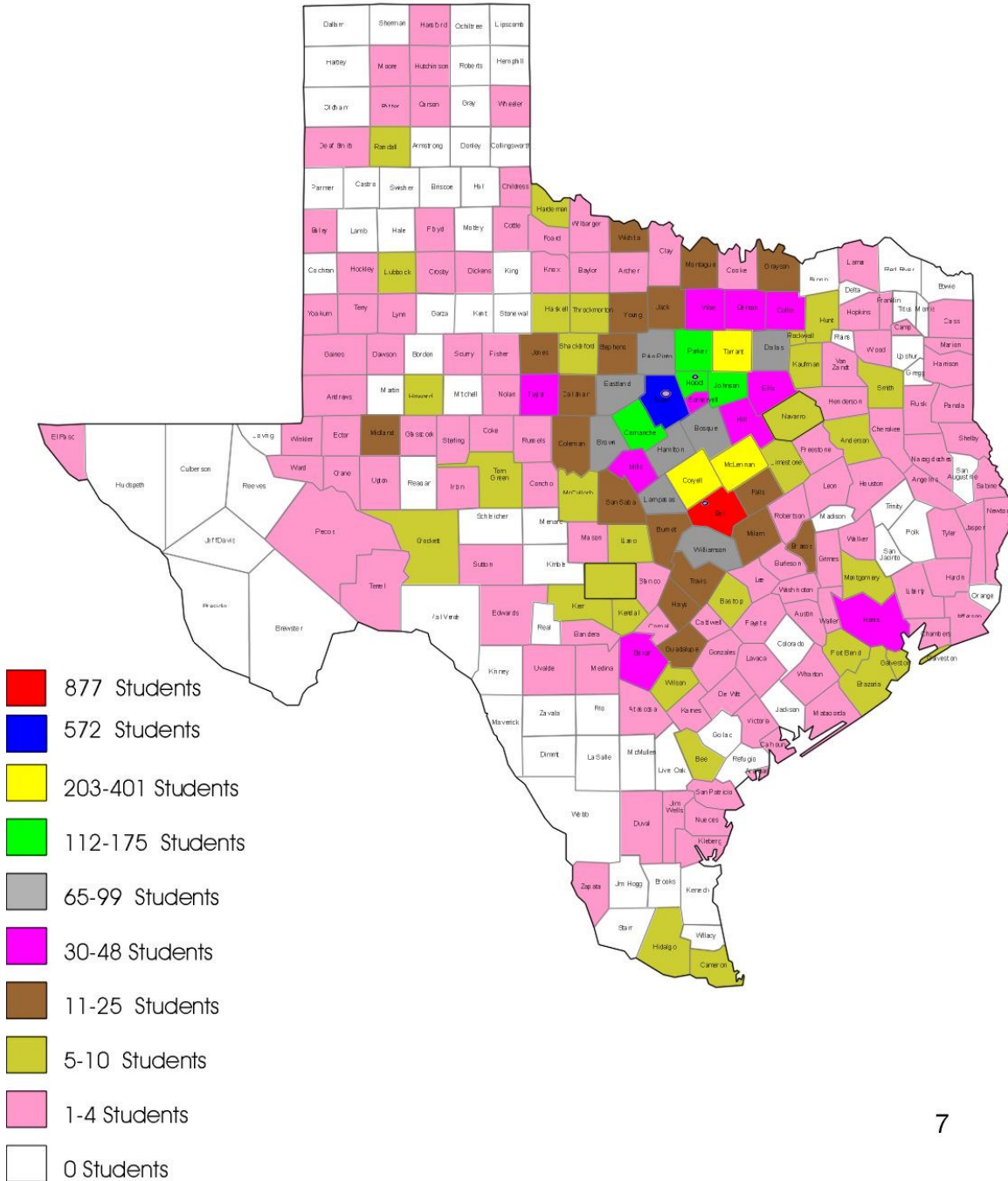

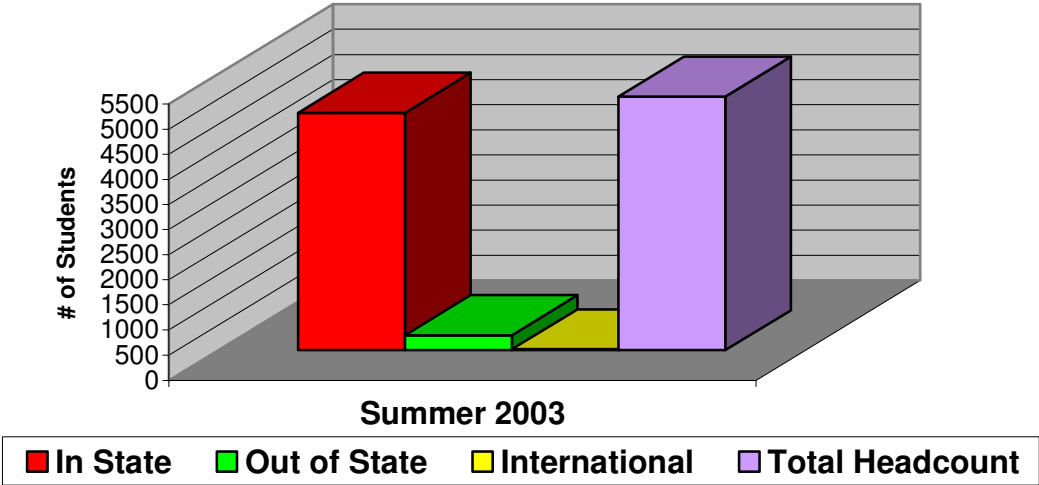

**Student Headcount by Geographical Origins**



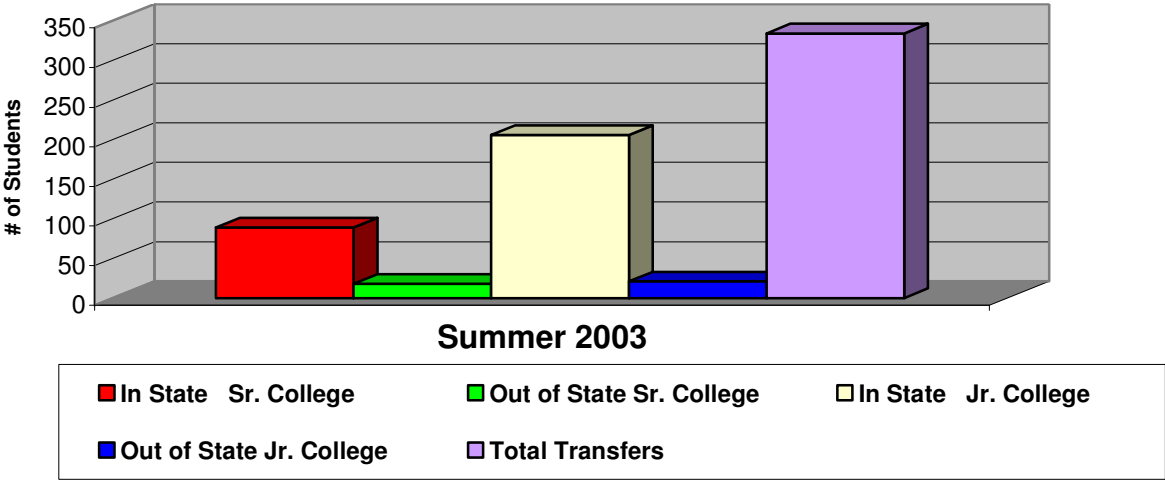

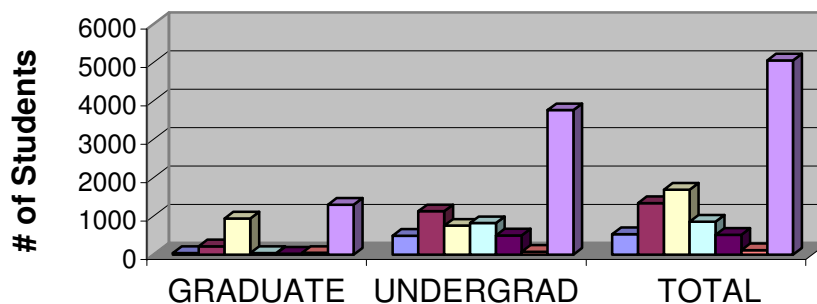

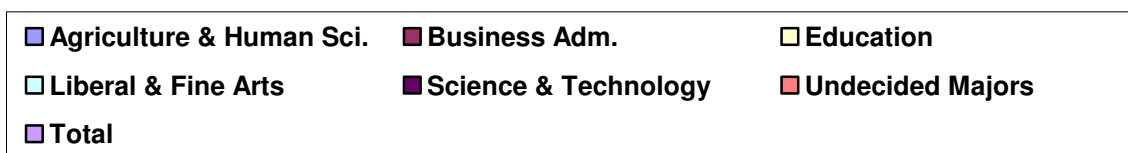
**Student Headcount by Transfer College Type**

Student Headcount by College Summer 2003**



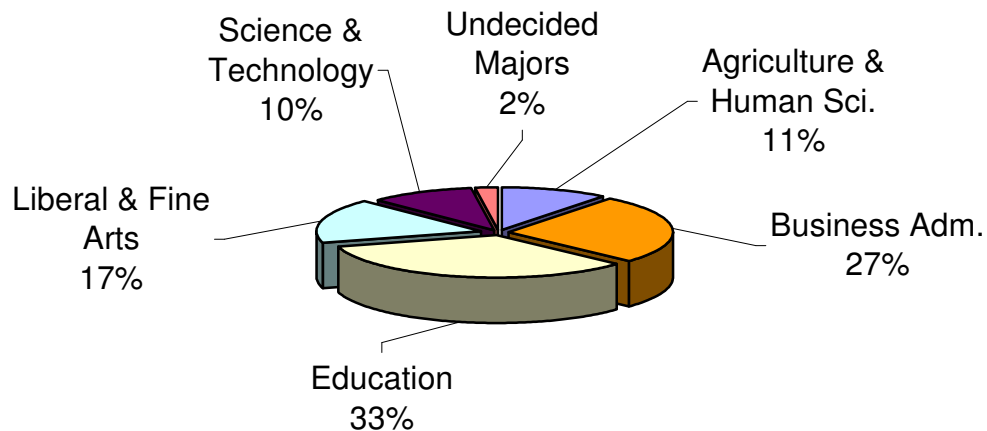

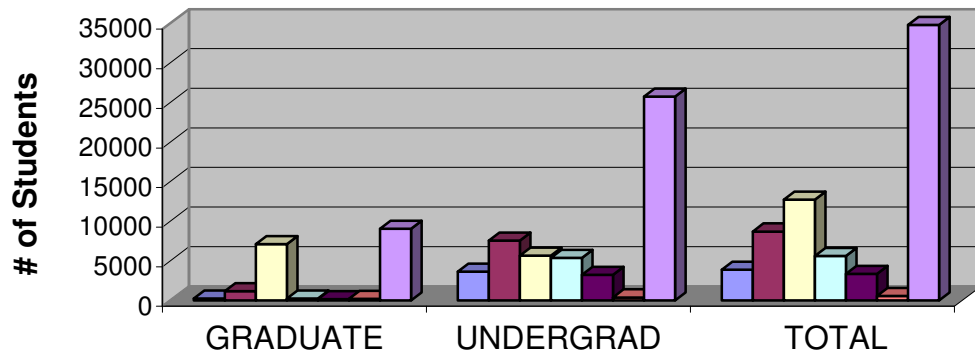

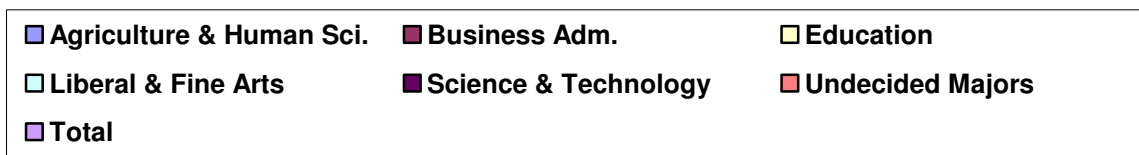
**2003 Summer Headcount By College**

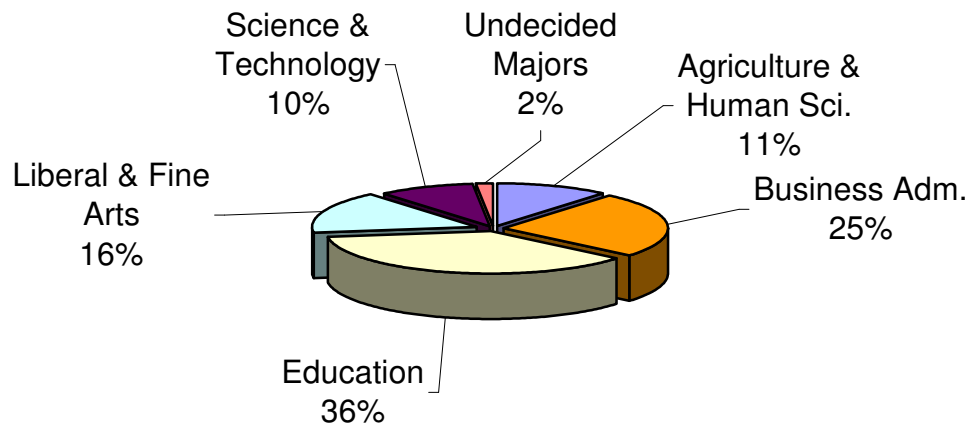

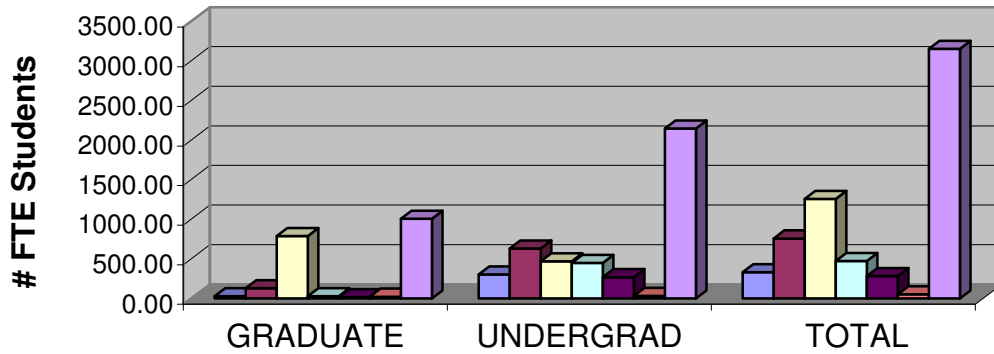

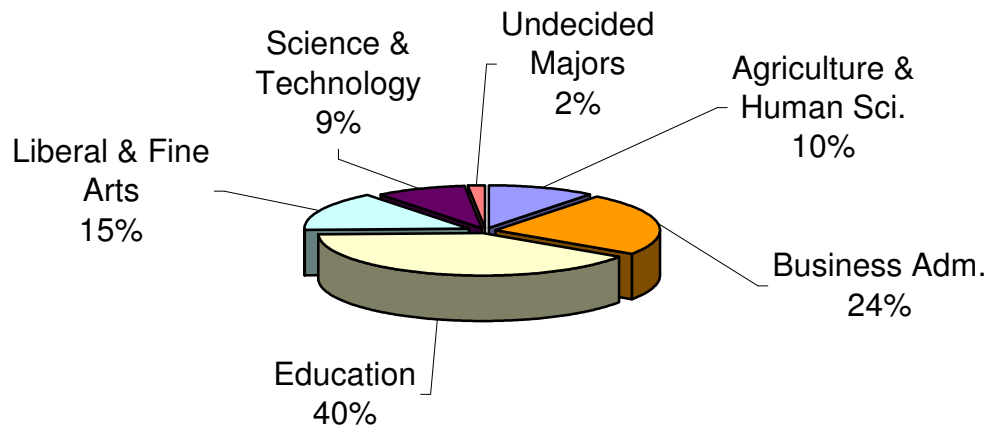

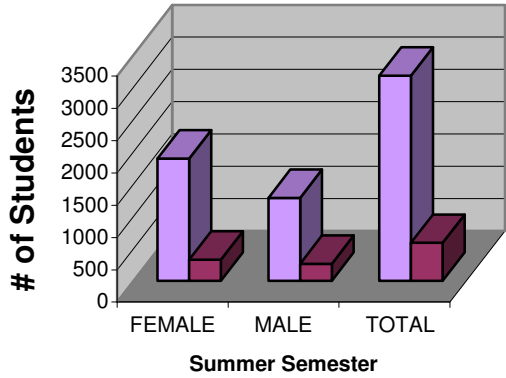

**2003 Summer FTE By College**



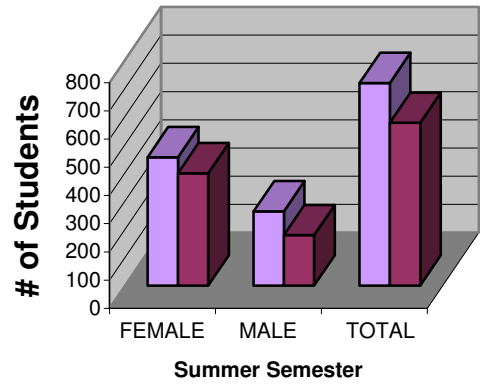

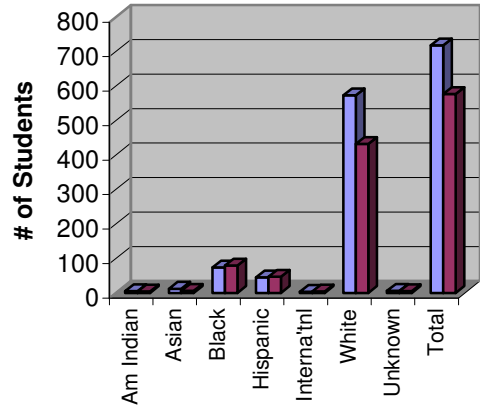

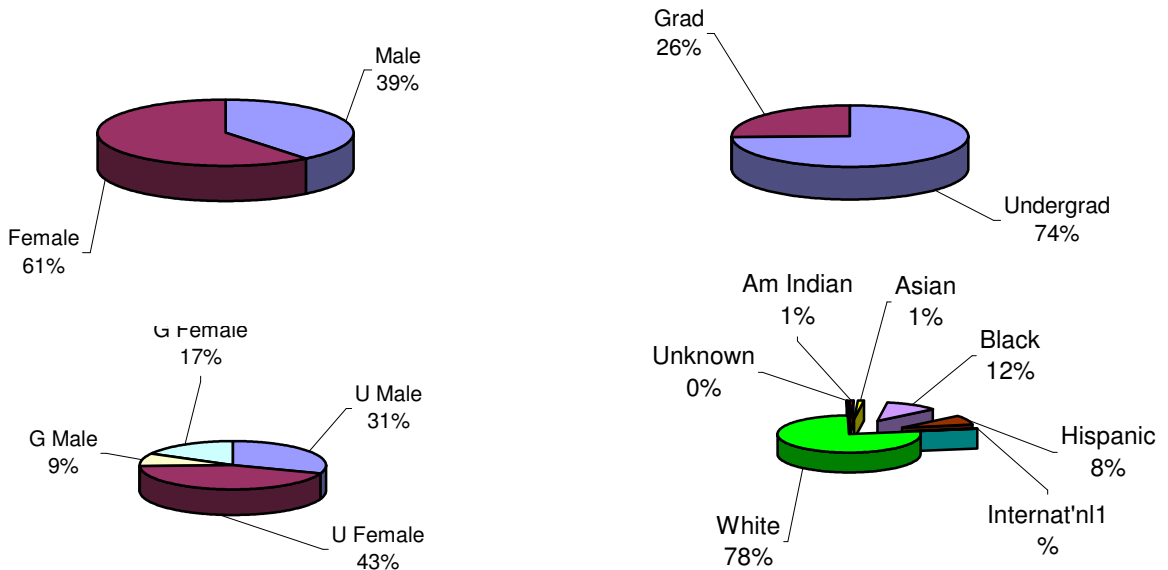

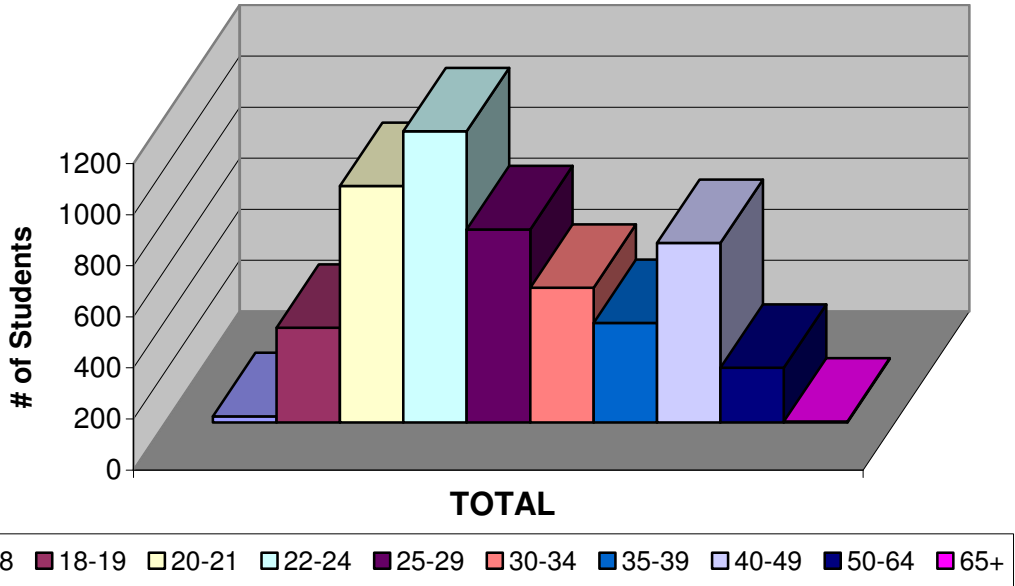

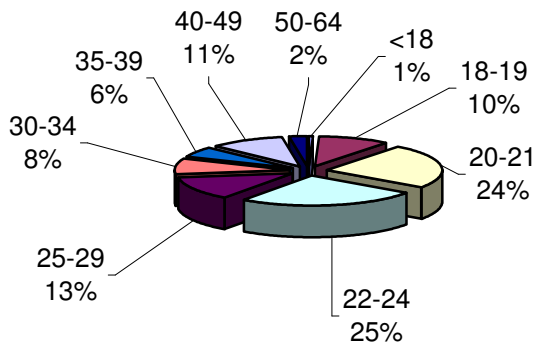
