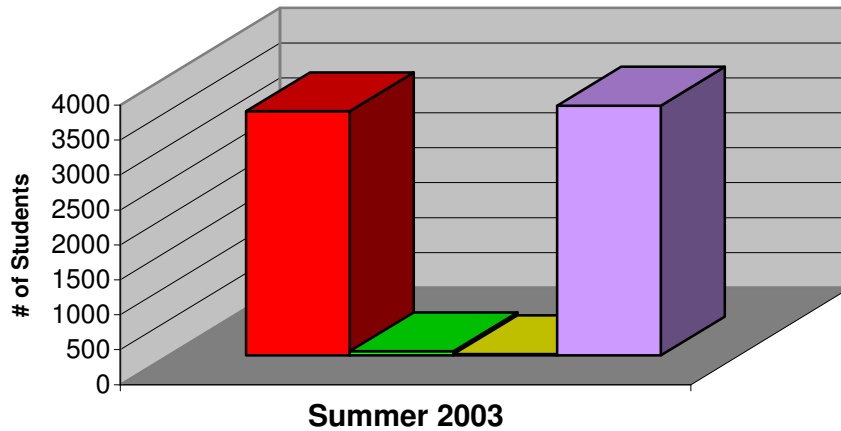

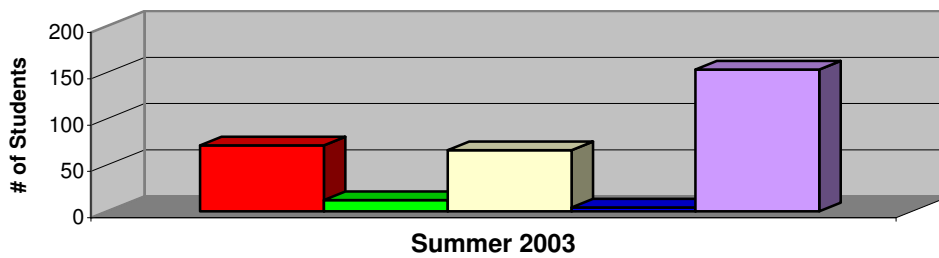

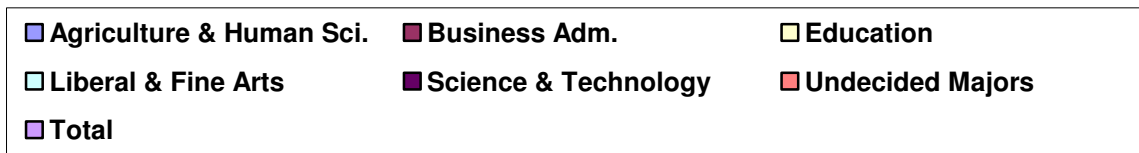

Student Headcount by College Summer 2003**



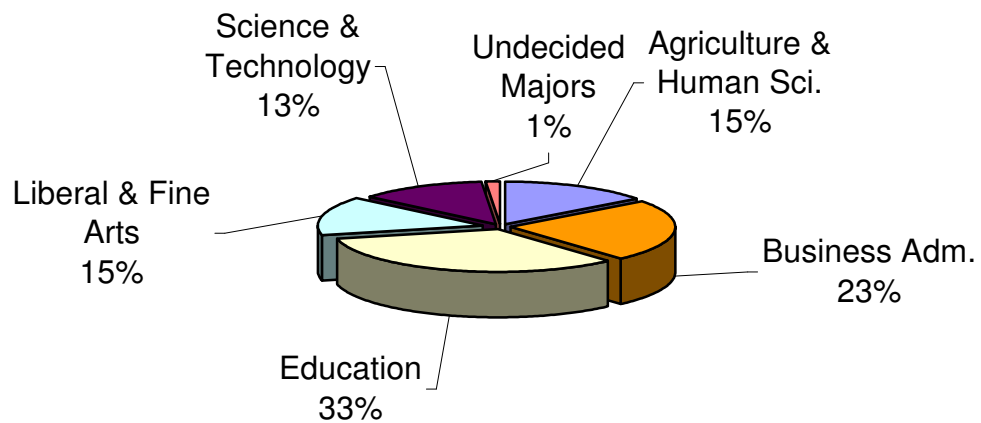

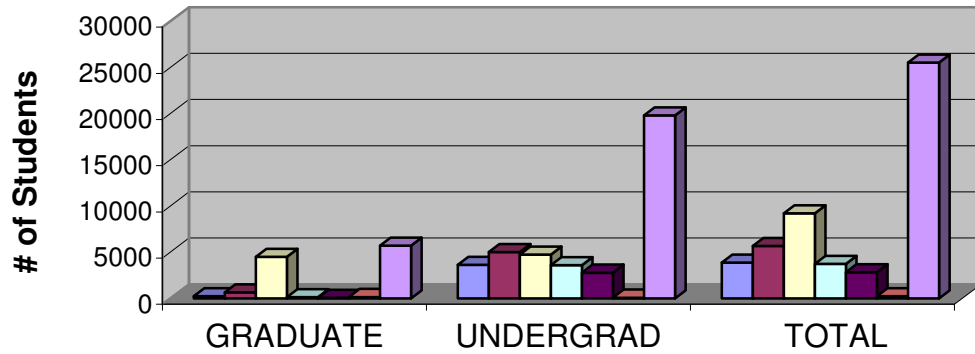

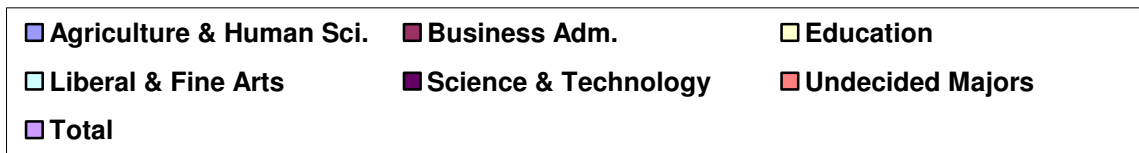
**2003 Summer Headcount By College**

**Semester Credit Hours Taken by Majors Within Colleges - Summer 2003**



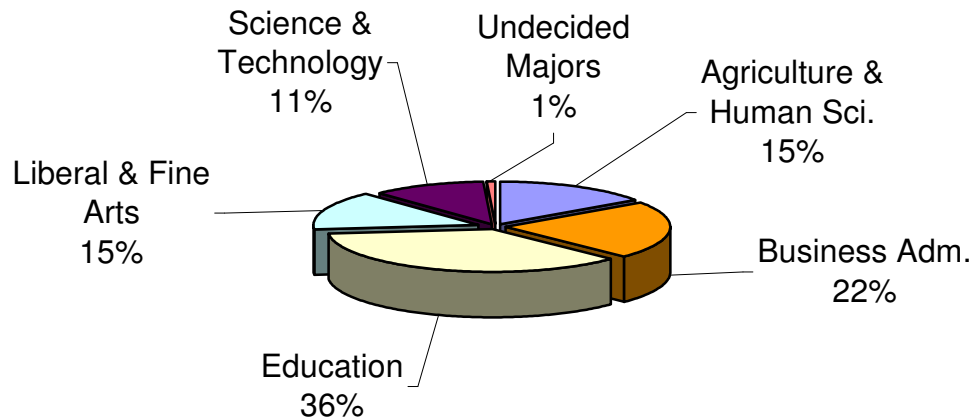

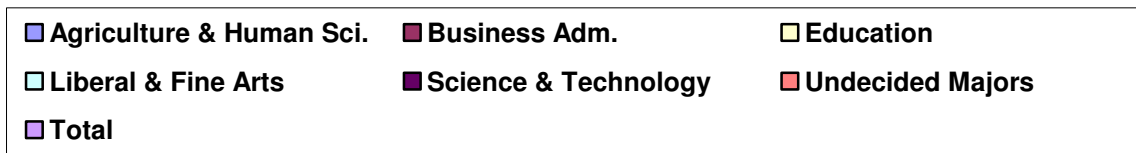

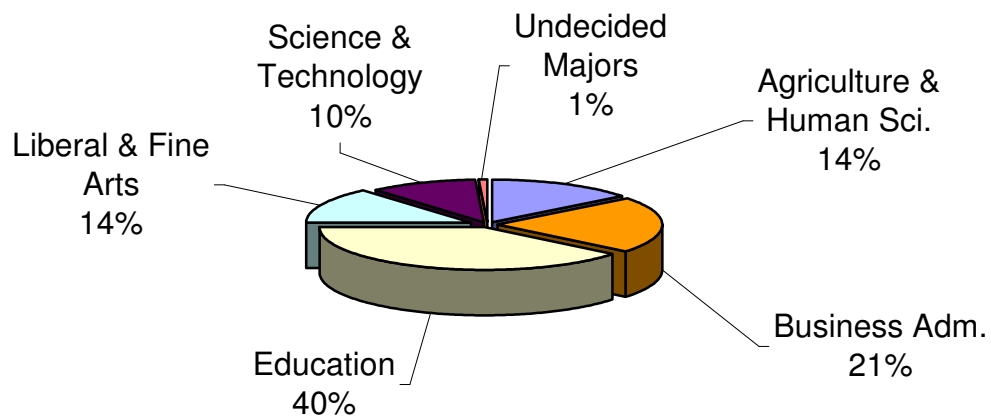

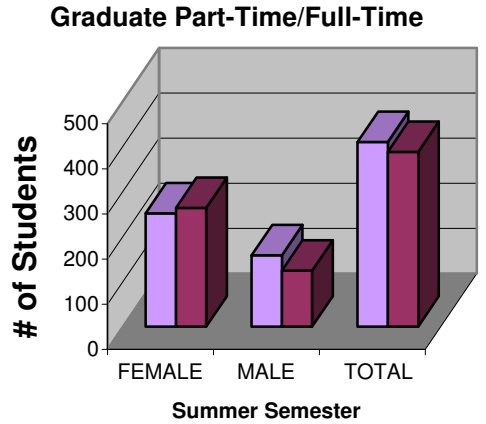
**2003 Summer FTE By College**

**Part-Time/Full-Time Headcount by Gender/Status - Summer 2003**



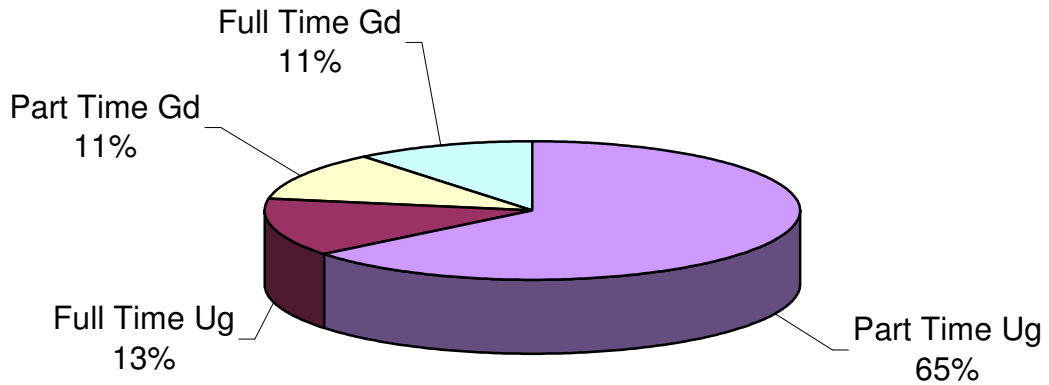

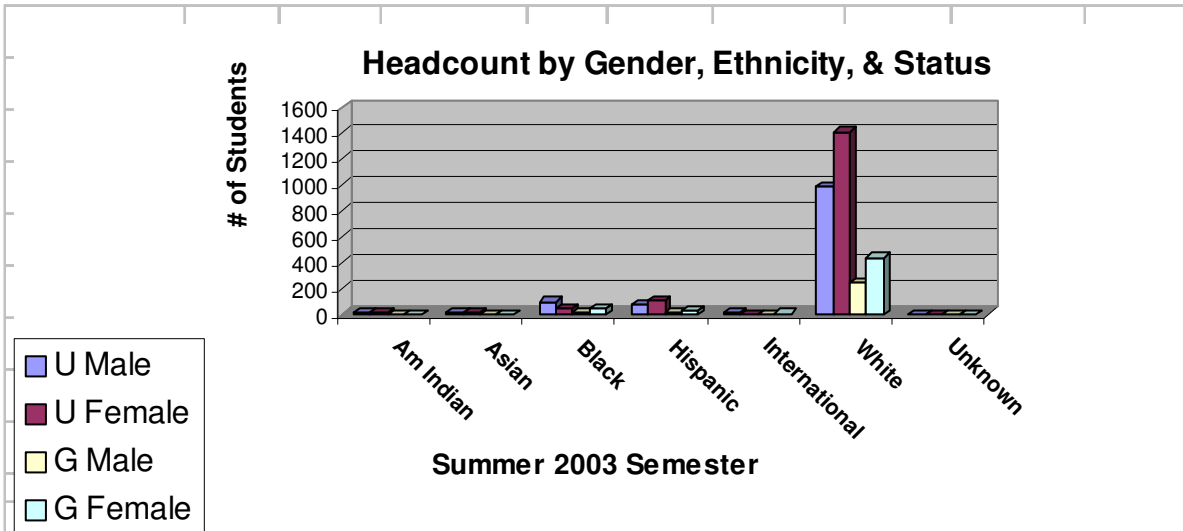

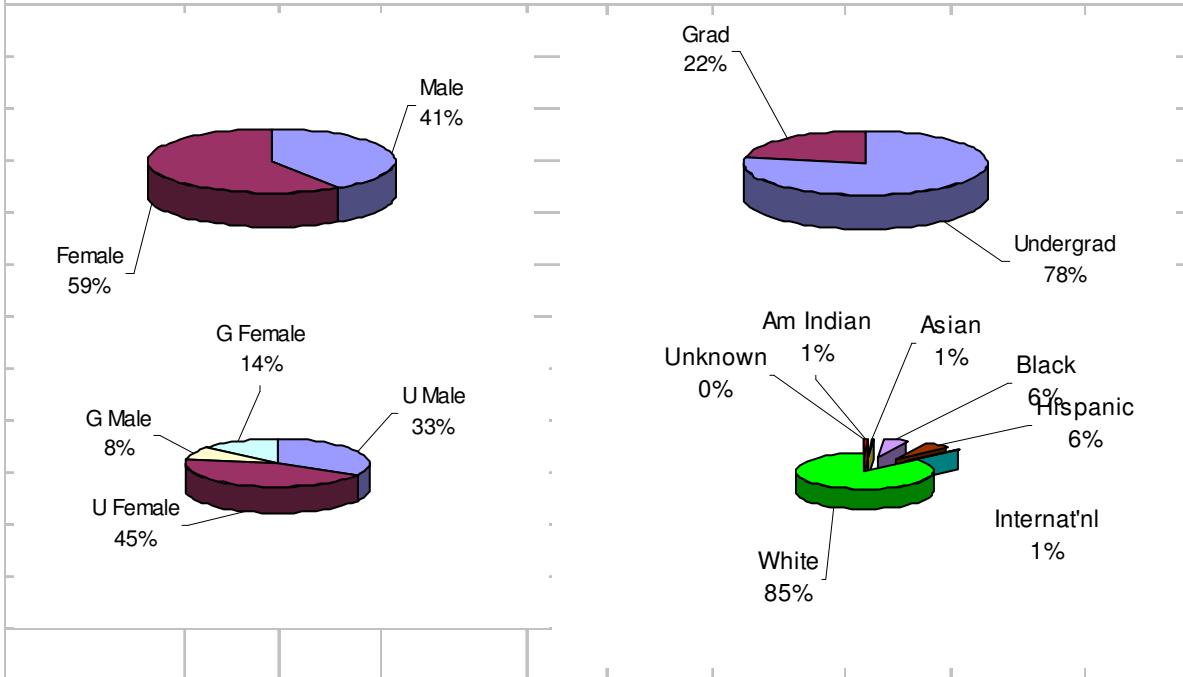

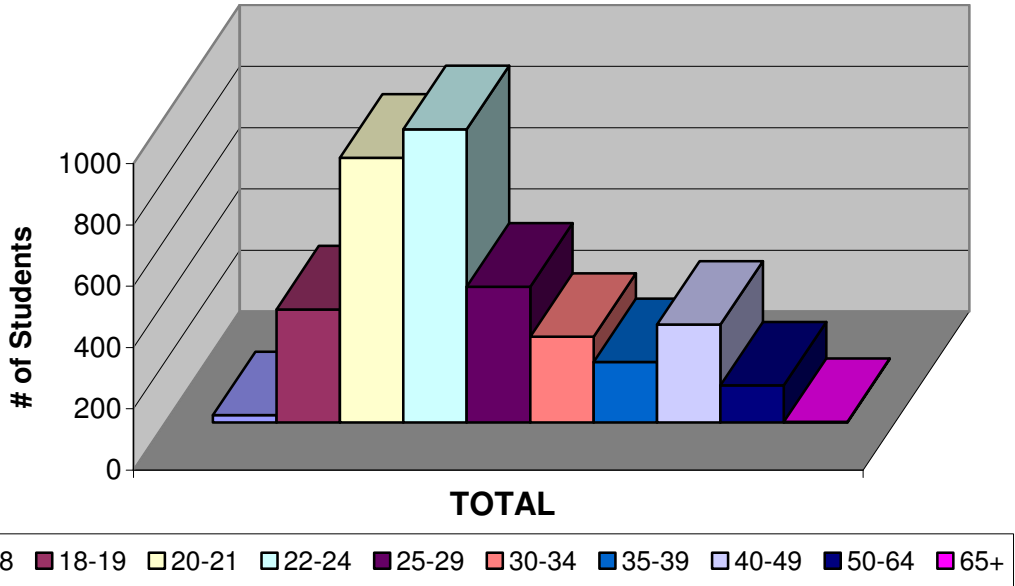

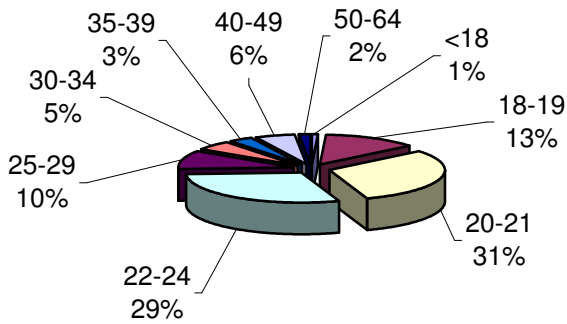
