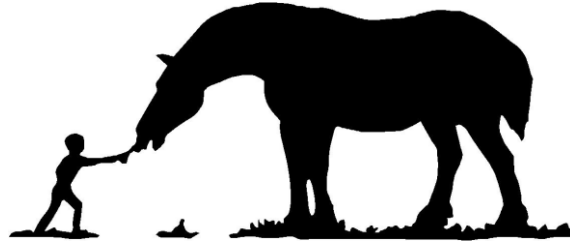


TARLETON EQUINE ASSISTED THERAPY

Tarleton Equine Assisted Therapy (TREAT) was established in 1995 to provide therapeutic riding opportunities for special needs individuals in Stephenville and the surrounding community. TREAT also serves as a training program for Tarleton State University students who wish to work in the therapeutic riding industry. Riders are charged a nominal fee but most of the expenses for care and maintenance of the horses, tack and other equipment must come from donations from individuals, civic organizations, and businesses.

YOU CAN HELP

ADOPT A CHILD - A donation of \$500 will provide a “scholarship” to cover the rider fee for a child for one year. Many of the special needs children in the Stephenville area simply cannot afford the rider fee. Generous donations are providing riding experiences for 6 of these children this session and more scholarships are needed.

ADOPT A HORSE - The cost of feed and maintenance for a horse in TREAT is \$1,500 per year. There are 15 “bomb proof” horses dedicated to TREAT. Donations for the support of these valuable horses will allow the program to expand and serve more riders.
