2. Status for Fifth Year Interim Report

3. <u>Calendar</u>

- Under the new calendar the AAC will conduct their annual program reviews between now and September 10th.
- Under the new calendar the AAC will conduct their follow-up reviews between September 25th and October 10th.
- This gives programs two weeks (from Sept. 10 Sept. 24) to make the changes indicated in the annual reviews we are completing.
- The AAC follow-up reviews begin on Sept. 25 and MUST be completed no later than October 10.

4. Review Process

The main focus of this meeting was to prepare the Academic Assessment Committee to do their follow-up reviews. As such procedures for conducting the follow up reviews were discussed as well as discussing any issues that arose during the first round of reviews. While no major issues occurred during the first round reviews, the committee did note some useful small wording changes that were tracked to be revised before the reviews were used again next year.

5. Program Reviews for 5th Year Interim Report

Committee members were asked to:

- Please remind your department heads and program leaders of the importance of doing a review of their past five
 years of assessment planning in WEAVE to make sure they are demonstrating an ongoing pattern of effective
 assessment practice. This includes, but is not limited to:
 - o A holistic well designed, student learning focused assessment plan
 - o Three years of assessment findings for each objective
 - A documented history of the use of assessment findings in constructing, implementing, and completing student learning focused action plans
