# 2019 – 2020 Academic Assessment Calendar

## The Academic Assessment Year Runs September 1 – August 31

Note: This calendar is for <u>core and program academic assessment</u>.

#### Academic Assessment work to be completed by:

#### August 2019

20th: By this date Academic Program faculty should

- Enter into Weave all Core Course and Program academic assessment findings for the just ending 2018-19 academic assessment year.
- Ensure there are written Fall 2018 and Spring 2019 semester updates in the description of each action plan in the Core Course and Program Weave assessment plans. These action plan updates should be detailed about what specific assessment findings led to the creation of the action plan, what the action plan is, and what has been specifically done/achieved as a result of the action plans. Note: An action plan needs to be created for any measure that did not meet its target. There should also always be at least one in-progress action plan focused on improving student learning.

**31**<sup>th</sup>: By this date <u>Academic Program faculty</u> should have held a pre-semester academic assessment program meeting at which they **collaboratively**:

- Reviewed their Core Course and Program academic assessment findings and action plans for the just ending 2018-19 academic assessment year,
- Discussed the overall assessment plan for the program (including mission, goals, objectives, measures, targets, findings, action plans, course map, and sustainability map) in light of these findings and entered any changes to this plan, including any newly created action plans, into Weave,
- Ensured that all program faculty are clear on their assessment data gathering and action plan responsibilities for the coming year.

#### September 2019

**30**<sup>th</sup>: The <u>General Education and Academic Assessment Committee</u> completes an annual review of Academic Programs' previous year's assessment results and current year's assessment plans.

#### October 2019

**5**<sup>th</sup>: By this date <u>Deans</u> review and discuss Academic Programs' action plans and analysis for the year just ended and the current year with department heads/program leaders.

**14**<sup>h</sup>: Academic Program faculty complete revisions to their assessment plans based on Academic Assessment Committee feedback.

**30**<sup>th</sup>: General Education and Academic Assessment Committee completes follow-up reviews of academic programs' assessment plan revisions.

#### November 2019

**30**<sup>th</sup>: The <u>Academic Assessment Director</u> completes the *Annual Academic Assessment Compliance Report* 

## January 2020

**16**th: By this date **Academic Program faculty** should

- Enter all Core Course and Program academic assessment findings for the just ending Fall 2019 semester into Weave.
- Ensure each Core Course and Program action plan in Weave has a written Fall 2019 semester update of progress made on the action plan in the Fall 2019 semester and activity anticipated on the action plan in the Spring 2020 semester. These action plan updates should be detailed about what specific assessment findings led to the creation of the action plan, what the action plan is, and what has been specifically done/achieved as a result of the action plans. Note: An action plan needs to be created for any measure that did not meet its target. There should also always be at least one in-progress action plan focused on improving student learning.
- Ensure that all program faculty are clear on their Core Course and Program assessment data gathering and action plan responsibilities for Spring 2020 semester.
- **Collaboratively** review the status of the program based on assessment findings and action plan activity.

#### March 2020

**8<sup>th</sup>:** The <u>General Education and Academic Assessment Committee</u> completes mid-year holistic review of academic programs' assessment plans

### May 2020

#### 31st: By this date Academic Program faculty should

- Enter all Core Course and Program academic assessment findings for the just ending Spring 2020 semester into Weave.
- Ensure each Core Course and Program action plan in Weave has a written Spring 2020 semester update of progress made on the action plan in the Spring 2020 semester and activity anticipated on the action plan in the Summer 2020 semester. These action plan updates should be detailed about what specific assessment findings led to the creation of the action plan, what the action plan is, and what has been specifically done/achieved as a result of the action plans. Note: An action plan needs to be created for any measure that did not meet its target. There should also always be at least one in-progress action plan focused on improving student learning.
- Ensure that all program faculty are clear on their assessment data gathering and action plan responsibilities for Summer 2020 semester.
- **Collaboratively** review the status of the program based on assessment findings and action plan activity and begin planning for the 2020-21 academic assessment year.

## August 2020

## **16<sup>th</sup>:** By this date **Academic Program faculty** should

- Enter all Core Course and Program academic assessment findings for the just ending 2019-20 academic assessment year into Weave.
- Ensure there are written Fall 2019 and Spring 2020 semester updates in the Core
  Course and Program WEAVE assessment plan. These action plan updates should be
  detailed about what specific assessment findings led to the creation of the action
  plan, what the action plan is, and what has been specifically done/achieved as a
  result of the action plans. Note: An action plan needs to be created for any
  measure that did not meet its target. There should also always be at least one inprogress action plan focused on improving student learning.
