DESCRIPTION:

Under supervision of the Youth Services Coordinator:

- Provides ongoing case management services and rehabilitation services for youth with mental illness
- Coordinates and provides services
- Demonstrates a positive role model to youth and advocates on their and their families' behalves
- Responsible for coordination, planning and implementation of the recovery plan
- Participates in the on-call rotation for crisis resolution for youth

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Knowledge of youth issues in a rural setting
- Ability to network with schools, juvenile probation and other social service agencies to facilitate services for youth
- Ability to communicate with youth and their families to promote compliance with recovery plans
- Must be able to work independently and remain flexible to solve problems and crisis
- Knowledge and ability to perform basic computer skills a necessity
- Must be familiar with, and/or willing to be trained in, trauma-informed care
- Understanding, recognizing, and responding to the effects of all types of trauma, and an ability to work in a behavioral environment where staff convey dignity, respect, hopefulness, and the opportunity for choice and empowerment among consumers.

Required Education and Experience:

- Bachelor's degree in a human services field from an accredited college or university
- Master's degree preferred
- Two years direct experience with mentally ill youth in a community setting is preferred
- No professional license is required
- QMHP-CS status is necessary
- Must be able to utilize an electronic health record system to document collaboratively and concurrently with consumers across all processes, including assessment, service planning, and ongoing consumer-provider interactions
- A valid Texas driver's license and good driving record is required along with a copy of a valid auto insurance card

Physical Requirements/Work Environment:

Must be able to bend, stoop, kneel, crouch, squat, lift 25 pounds, sit for an extended period, and reach overhead

Application Requirements:

- Credentialing is required for this position
- Submit a copy of your unofficial transcript with your application.
- If you are selected for hire an official transcript will be required
- An Application for Employment is required
- A resume may be submitted; however, it will not replace an employment application
