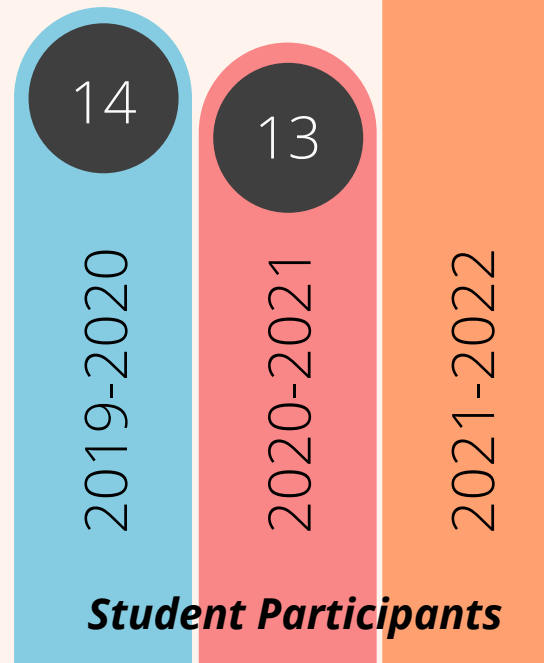


Community Service Program
